

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

February 3 is the Feast of St. Blaise. We will be blessing throats at the end of each Mass this weekend. St. Blaise was a fourth century Bishop from Armenia. He is remembered for offering a prayer over a boy who was choking on a fish bone; the boy promptly coughed up the bone. St. Blaise died a martyr's death and

has been venerated as a patron of those with diseases of the throat.

Next weekend, we will be passing out Rice Bowls. Catholic Relief Service is the agency of the US Catholic Church which helps areas of poverty around the globe. The Rice Bowl project brings back memories; this has been around since I was a teen. The idea is to keep the Rice Bowl (actually a little cardboard box) on your dinner table and drop in coins through Lent. Of course, an alternate idea is to write a generous check to help the poor.

The Season of Lent is almost upon us. Ash Wednesday falls on February 14, just a week and a half away. Now is the time to start thinking about Lent and making a plan to set this sacred time apart. Prayer, fasting and almsgiving are the traditional practices of Lent. We are offering many opportunities in the parish: Stations of the Cross will be offered on Friday evenings and Sunday afternoons; lectures on Catholic Faith Topics will be offered on Saturday morning; a series of presentations and discussion about the Eucharistic Prayer will be offered on Wednesday mornings; and our 40 Hours Devotion will be held from the evening of February 25 until the evening of Feb. 27.

I have recently spoken with two different single people who have not received Holy Communion for some years because they thought they were not allowed to receive sacraments after a divorce. To clear up any misunderstanding: a Catholic who has suffered through a divorce is in need of all of the compassion and help the Church can offer. This is a person who needs Holy Communion and should receive the Sacrament. A Catholic who divorces and then remarries outside of the Catholic Church should refrain from receiving Communion unless we can resolve the situation with an annulment and a blessing of the marriage. But there is no impediment for a divorced person who is living a single life. Those who are hurting are especially in need of Holy Communion.

Due to the closing, you can no longer save credit statements for the future.

Remember, your portion of the money can be used for many different things, such as school tuition or lunch accounts, donating it to the St. Vincent DePaul Society, Capital Improvement Fund, or other parish ministries. If you do not want to use your credits for these options, you may request a refund in the form of a family rebate check.

We have researched our records and found many outstanding credits from the past. Even if you haven't purchased SCRIP in a while, please call or stop by the Parish Office and check if you have any unclaimed statements. However, if we do not have a signed report by March 31, 2024, we will be required to turn the money over to the State of Indiana as unclaimed funds.
