A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

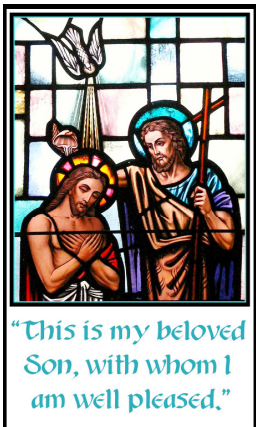
Father Dennis is already very much missed here at St. Charles. We wish him the best in his new assignment, St. Robert Bellarmine in North Manchester.



The Bishop hopes to send another priest to St. Charles in June, but he does not foresee sending anyone before that. Fr. James and I are going to do our best to maintain the current sacramental schedule in our parish. We are edified to see so many people at daily Masses and we are thrilled with the number of people coming for confessions. I think that part of the reason for the impressive life of prayer in this parish is the convenient, regular and predictable schedule of those two sacraments. When we add our nursing home Masses, wedding and funeral Masses, this isn't a schedule which would be feasible long-term for a two-priest parish. However, I don't want to make any changes in the schedule which might discourage people from coming for these sacraments. For the coming months we will call on other priests for help when needed, and we hope for a rescue in June. Please pray for extra priestly vigor.

Our parish sends a monthly check to four local parishes, "twinning" with parishes in needier neighborhoods. This is part of our Christian call to share our gifts with others. You will remember that last year we added a seminary in East Africa as our fifth twin. We received a beautiful Christmas card from St. Mary's Seminary in Fort Portal, Uganda, along with their thanks. "St. Mary's Seminary-Virika with great pleasure wishes the St. Charles Borromeo Parish Community joyous and nice celebration of the festive season of Christmas and a prosperous new year 2020!" A few dollars will go a long way in Uganda, I think that St. Charles Borromeo, patron of seminarians, would be pleased.

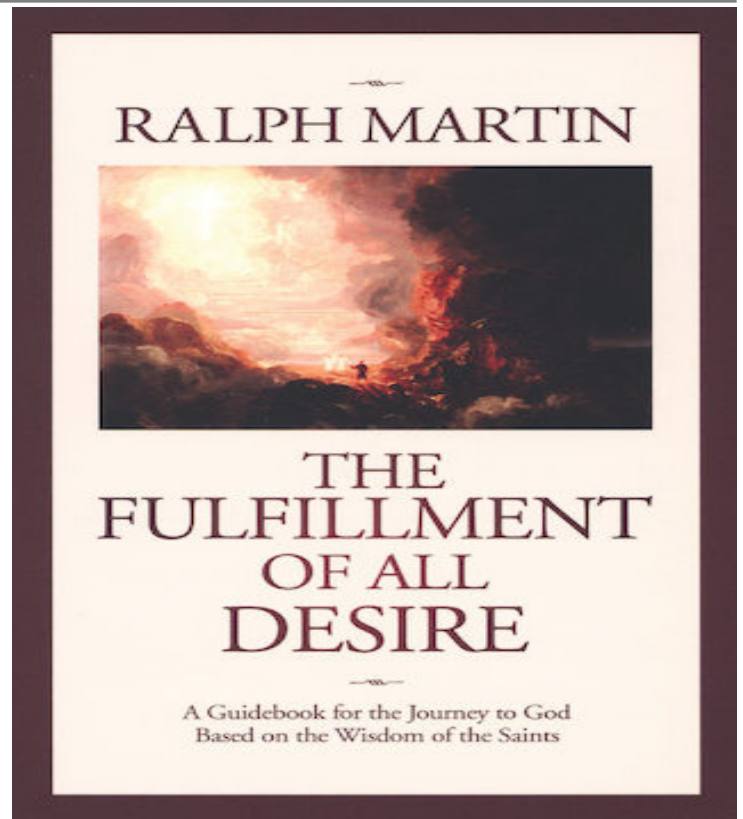

Pre-K4 & Kindergarten Registration At St. Charles Coming Soon!

January 21, 2020!

We wish to invite you to our Kindergarten & Pre-Kindergarten registration day on **Tuesday, January 21**. Registration will be held in the afternoon from 1:15 p.m.-2:30 p.m. in Rooms C & D of the Hession Center, or you may attend the evening session from 6:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m. in the Art Room. All parents are asked to park in the rear of the school and enter through door # 3.

Kindergarten: For this coming school year 2020-2021, we will be offering full-day Kindergarten with a class size limit of 27 students per class. Our school day runs from 7:50 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. If you have need, for an additional fee, we will offer our Before Care and After Care service for all students.

Initial tuition costs are projected to be \$3,804 (\$317 per month over 12 months) for the full-day program - plus a one-time \$40 registration fee.

Pre-Kindergarten four-year-old Program: We will be offering two sessions of five-day Pre-Kindergarten classes (A.M., P.M., or Full-day). Our morning program will run from 7:50 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. and our afternoon program will run from 11:50 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Initial tuition costs are projected to be \$3,804 (\$317 per month over 12 months) for the full-day program, or \$1,902 (\$159 per month over 12 months) - plus a one-time \$40 registration fee.

Our January registration for our Kindergarten and Pre-K 4 Programs is early enough to ensure that parish families of St. Charles Borromeo have a first opportunity to register their children. Please bring to registration:

1. A copy of your child's Social Security card, birth certificate and baptismal certificate.
2. We will also need a copy of your child's immunization record.
3. The registration fee is \$40.00 and is nonrefundable.
