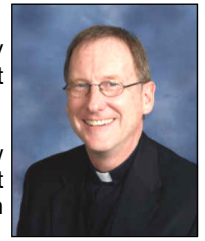

January is the time of year when we look back, remembering what the past year has meant to us. Let me share a few memories of our past year at St. Charles. Last February, a group of enthusiastic volunteers organized the first *Borromeo Bash*, a dinner/auction/fundraiser for our school. It was a phenomenal success. Nationally-known musician John Angotti spent a day singing with our school children.

In March we began Lent, including lots of confessions, Stations of the Cross, and growing numbers of people at daily Mass. A *Knights of Columbus* fish fry ran out of fish after serving 1100 people. Holy Week included the mounting of a new cross on our church roof as our roofing project began. On Good Friday, parishioners from St. Patrick offered a dramatic presentation of the Passion, and the week culminated in 18 new Catholics welcomed into the Church.

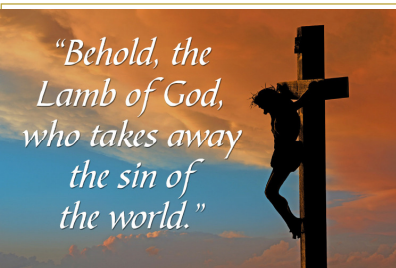
The summer began with a new parish young adult ministry program, and Fr. Phil DeVolder leaving us after a year of convalescence and ministry at St. Charles. Noah Isch was accepted as a seminarian for our diocese and Jacob Eifrid took his first vows with the Holy Cross brothers. In July, new gardening crews started work on our parish grounds and Boy Scouts painted our softball dugouts.

In August, our school opened with a growing enrollment and Sam Martinez was announced as another seminarian from our parish. September brought a wonderful CardinalFest and a sigh of relief when the new church roof was finally finished. In October, Dr. Ray Guarendi gave a talk at St. Charles and Fr. Tom joined a group of parishioners for a pilgrimage to Rome. In November, the Bishop Confirmed 100 of our teens and in December we had a joyful celebration of Christmas, though saddened by the news that Fr. Dennis would be leaving our parish.

Most important, though, 2019 was a year in which we did our best to live the faith. We celebrated 88 baptisms and another eight baptized Christians joined the Catholic Church. 23 couples were married, and we celebrated 68 funerals, commending loved ones to the Lord, and asking for the Kingdom of Heaven.

May God Continue to Bless Us in 2020.

ST. CHARLES USHERS - REQUEST FOR THE NEW YEAR—2020

We've made a lot of progress filling usher openings, but there is more to do.

In November 2019, Fr. Tom met with all existing ushers and those parishioners interested in becoming ushers for St. Charles. The good news: the call-to-service was successful. We received good response and were able to shore-up most of our Saturday evening and Sunday morning usher teams. Many thanks go out to those who were able to volunteer as new ushers or for existing ushers able to take on additional mass times.

We currently have five usher teams (i.e. teams A – E) for each mass time. This creates a 5 month rotating schedule for ushers with 1 month "on" and 4 months "off". The ministry is open to men, women, young adults, and students (starting around 5th grade) who want to be part of this ministry.

The 9:00 a.m. Sunday teams are fully staffed at 6 ushers for all teams. We average 5 ushers per team for Sat 5:00 p.m., Sunday 7:30 a.m., 9:00 a.m., and 11:00 a.m. Mass times – there are still a few openings during these times; if you can volunteer during one of these times, we can use the help. With 6 member teams (6 is our goal), each team can function well and still have room for the occasional team member absence.

Unfortunately, we still have across-the-board shortages for the 5:00 p.m. Sunday Masses. All five Sunday 5:00 p.m. teams are down to only 3 or 4 team members. If you are looking for a great way to help out St. Charles in the new year, please consider volunteering for one of the Sunday 5:00 p.m. usher teams. For those who want to help but can't commit to being full-time on a team, we are willing to consider part-time team members.

Pre-K4 & Kindergarten Registration At St. Charles Coming Soon!

January 21, 2020!

We wish to invite you to our Kindergarten & Pre-Kindergarten registration day on **Tuesday, January 21**. Registration will be held in the afternoon from 1:15 p.m.-2:30 p.m. in Rooms C & D of the Hession Center, or you may attend the evening session from 6:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m. in the Art Room. All parents are asked to park in the rear of the school and enter through door # 3.

Kindergarten: For this coming school year 2020-2021, we will be offering full-day Kindergarten with a class size limit of 27 students per class. Our school day runs from 7:50 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. If you have need, for an additional fee, we will offer our Before Care and After Care service for all students.

Initial tuition costs are projected to be \$3,804 (\$317 per month over 12 months) for the full-day program - plus a one-time \$40 registration fee.

Pre-Kindergarten four-year-old Program: We will be offering two sessions of five-day Pre-Kindergarten classes (A.M., P.M., or Full-day). Our morning program will run from 7:50 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. and our afternoon program will run from 11:50 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Initial tuition costs are projected to be \$3,804 (\$317 per month over 12 months) for the full-day program, or \$1,902 (\$159 per month over 12 months) - plus a one-time \$40 registration fee.

Our January registration for our Kindergarten and Pre-K 4 Programs is early enough to ensure that parish families of St. Charles Borromeo have a first opportunity to register their children. Please bring to registration:

1. A copy of your child's Social Security card, birth certificate and baptismal certificate.
2. We will also need a copy of your child's immunization record.
3. The registration fee is \$40.00 and is nonrefundable.
