A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We had two wonderful days of prayer this week with our 40 Hours Devotion and we were edified by the words of Fr. Patrick Mary. Catholics are a Eucharistic people. The Mass is the most important thing we do and we need to be reminded of that once in a while.

It was also important for us as a parish to welcome Fr. Patrick Mary back home. This was the first time he has celebrated a Mass at St. Charles since his first Mass, celebrated here 8 years ago. Words from one of our parishioners: We can see the results of parish prayer for vocations, not only in the numbers of seminarians who have come from our parish, but in the quality. We are watching answered prayers.

I will share some numbers from this year's Borromeo Bash. 470 people attended, with an additional 80 bidding for auction items online. The profits came to \$80,000 to help our school. Wow. Thanks are due to the volunteers who put an enormous amount of work into this effort and to all of the people who supported it. Profits from the Borromeo Bash are helping us in replacing windows on the school and upgrading restrooms.

On Friday evening, Fr. Herb Weber, a priest from Cincinnati, will speak about Catholic Relief Service and the ways that our US Church is helping in other parts of the world. Our parish CRS chapter will provide a very simple meatless dinner, using recipes from third world countries. Join us in the Hession Center at 7:30 p.m., after the Friday evening Stations. Fr. Herb will preach at most the weekend Masses next week.

This Thursday evening, March 7, is our annual "The Light is On for You" opportunity. Priests will be hearing confessions in every parish that evening from 6:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m.. Come on in for confession, or pick another parish.

We have an important event taking place at the 9:00 Mass next week. The Candidates from our RCIA group, those who are baptized in Protestant faiths, will be received into the Church at that Mass. After a profession of faith, they will be proclaimed Catholic. Then they will be Confirmed and will join us for Holy Communion. This is an important day in their lives and in the life of our parish.

THE LIGHT IS ON FOR YOU Thursday, March 7


