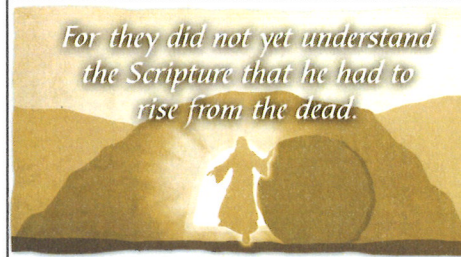

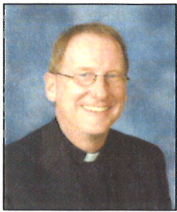

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We welcome guests and visitors who join us today for our greatest celebration—the Triumph of Christ over Sin and Death. If you don't have a church family, you may want to consider making St. Charles your home. Our website, stcharlesfortwayne.org, has information about the parish and a registration form to register in the parish. Thanks are due to the musicians, the church decorators, the many liturgical ministers and the office workers who have helped to make our Holy Week liturgies beautiful. Their hours of work have helped us to give glory to God and to be a prayerful people. I also need to add a personal thanks to Fr. James and Fr. Bobby for their long hours hearing confessions. We are thrilled to see so many people coming for this sacrament.

Next weekend, we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. Remembering the merciful love of Jesus, we come humbly before the Lord and ask for help. A Plenary Indulgence is offered for those who receive Holy Communion on Mercy Sunday, having confession within a span of 20 days before or after, and offering simple prayers for the Pope. See the flyer in this bulletin for more information. An indulgence is our chance to call upon Jesus as he brings someone through purgatory into heaven.

I offer another update concerning the large bequest our parish received in October. Before making final decisions on the use of the funds, we are tithing on the money received. We sent \$43,000 to Sri Lanka to buy a used car for newly-ordained Bishop Wimal, a Priest who was serving in our diocese but called home to be ordained a Bishop. (While that sounds like a lot of money for a used car, there is a 300% sales tax on cars in Sri Lanka.) We are now sending funds to St. John's School in South Bend (in serious need of a new roof), Queen of Angels in Fort Wayne (in need of HVAC repairs or replacement) and the Men's Discernment House in Fort Wayne (in need of siding, roofing and a sprinkler system.) It is a blessing to be able to help others in need.

We wish everyone a beautiful Easter. For eight days we celebrate the Easter Mass, filled with Alleluias. This is a beautiful time of year.

DIVINE MERCY IS FOR YOU

Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated annually on the first Sunday after Easter. A Plenary Indulgence removes all temporal punishment due to forgiven sin ("Temporal punishment" is the "making up" for sin to which we are obliged after we are forgiven). A Plenary Indulgence can be applied to one's self or to anyone who is deceased. A Plenary Indulgence can be gained once per day.

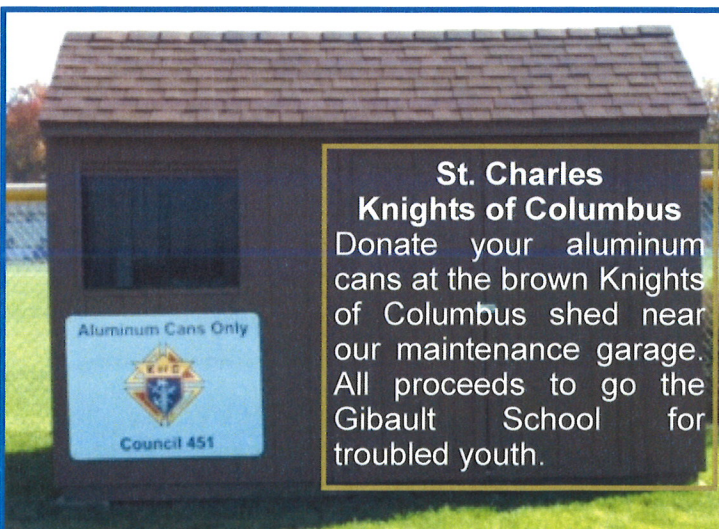
AVA'S GRACE
