A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

This is Divine Mercy Sunday, a time when we are especially reminded of the love of our God. A plenary indulgence is offered on Mercy Sunday for those who receive Holy Communion with a complete detachment from sin, Pray for the Pope's Intention, and have a Sacramental Confession within twenty days. More information is found on our parish website under *Events*.

An interesting event will take place in our church this Sunday evening, April 11. A group called "Gifted and Sent Ministries", headed by Fr. Drew Curry, will offer four Sunday events designed to help us find our hearts on fire. The first is this weekend. Jessica Smith will give a presentation on the Holy Spirit. Join us in the church at 7:00 p.m.

Another good event this week will be the organ concert in our church on Friday evening at 7:30 p.m. We have a wonderful organ and this will be a chance to hear a concert organist at work.

I repeat a note from a previous bulletin: we are due to cycle four new members into our parish council. The council meets monthly on a Wednesday evening, and we look at the spiritual life, social life, and outreach in our parish. The bishop and the diocesan Sacred Art and Architecture Committee have given us the green light to continue our research on our church restoration project. In addition to a church architect, we are now talking to a sound engineer, a lighting design specialist, and a company that protects pipe organs during construction.

A report will be sent out soon on the results of our Offertory Increase program in February. We have a generous parish and we are grateful for the response. A note: the Commitment Cards which we turned in were nothing more than a record of our intentions. One parishioner told me that he was surprised that his automatic donations didn't change after he turned in the Commitment Card. **DIVINE MERCY PLENARY INDULGENCE**

In 2002, St. John Paul II established the Sunday after Easter as the Feast of Divine Mercy and offered a plenary indulgence on this day. Once sins are forgiven in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, a plenary indulgence then removes the temporal punishment for those sins. We can gain an indulgence for ourselves, or we can offer the indulgence for a soul in purgatory, helping them on their way to the glories of heaven. This can be the chance to offer the greatest of gifts to a loved one who has gone before us.

Requirements for the indulgence: 1) make a sincere confession within 20 days before or after the feast day. 2) Receive Holy Communion at a Feast Day Mass. 3) Offer prayers for the intention of Pope Francis. 4) Approach this with a complete detachment from sin. 
