It is a friendly group, which has come up with many good ideas and insights. Our meetings are usually finished in an hour.

Redeemer Radio is our local Catholic Radio Station, FM 106.3. The station provides opportunity to learn more about the faith, to hear from our bishop, and to stop and pray during the course of the day. The station's Spring Sharathon will be taking place this week, with our St. Charles hour from 3:00 p.m.-4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 19. Please tune us in and please make a pledge to support Catholic radio.

I again want to thank our parish musicians, decorators, clergy, liturgy planners, our Communion ministers, servers, readers and ushers for all of the extra efforts put into Holy Week liturgies. We had a beautiful week. I am also grateful to the group from St. Patrick Parish who offered a dramatic Stations of the Cross on Good Friday. For those who missed it, it was a beautiful expression of faith.

Save the Date: Deacon Jake Schneider, a lifelong St. Charles parishioner, will be ordained a priest on June 3. With seven young men being ordained, seating at the Cathedral will be very limited and we encourage everyone to follow the diocesan livestream. However, everyone is invited to St. Charles on June 4, for Fr. Jake's First Mass. He will be the celebrant at our Sunday 11:00 a.m. Mass. This is a big day for the Church and for our parish.

While we are excited about the number of priests being ordained, for the past few years the diocese has had dropping numbers of seminarians. If we have any young men in the parish who are wondering if they might have the call, I encourage you to talk to a priest. I can't imagine a life more fulfilling. I would also like to encourage any young woman who might wonder about religious life. Our religious are wonderful witnesses in the world and a great blessing to the Church.



#### The St. Vincent DePaul Society

The St. Charles Council of St. Vincent dePaul Society will meet on Monday, April 17, at 7:00 p.m. in the Hession Center, Room B. Our organization does many different corporal works of mercy, such as feeding the hungry and clothing the naked. If this is something that is important to you, please plan to attend our next meeting to find out how you can lend a hand.

During the month of March, we were able to help 127 individuals consisting of 77 adults and 50 children. We provided \$ 4,287 in rent and motel stays, \$ 3,241.22 in utility payments, \$ 1,796 in car repair, \$ 800 in cards for gas and food, \$ 1,232 for furniture and household items and \$ 247 for food which provided 1,300 pounds of food. In addition, we give \$ 200 monthly to St. Patrick's Parish to help an immigrant family. We spent a total of \$ 11,802 to help the needy. This was an extremely busy month for us with many in need of rent and utility assistance.

Only through your generosity have we been able to help so many. We are very grateful for your continued support. Thank you.




#### EUCHARTISIC REVIVAL APRIL, 2023


