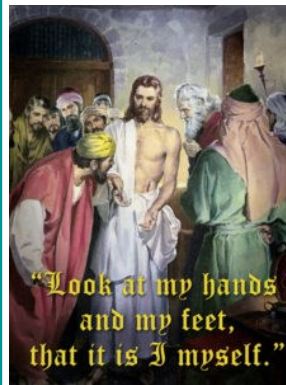

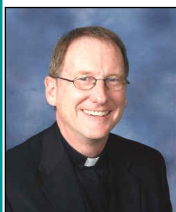

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

In February we began a program called *Sharing Jesus in our Family*. It was a chance to remind ourselves why it is important to be generous with our parish. It was also a chance for each of us to take a look at our giving and make a clear decision about future giving.

Within the next couple of weeks, you will receive a Summary Report of the program. Our offertory collections are growing. Your generosity shows your willingness as faithful stewards to be a part of the many good works of this parish.

With the Bishop's approval, we have removed the strings from two sections of pews this weekend in order to accommodate the growing number of people coming for Mass. The string remains in other sections, where we are still asking for spacing in alternate pews. If you are at-risk for the corona virus or if you are more comfortable maintaining distance, please sit in the areas which are still marked off with string, allowing more distance from your neighbors.
