



We welcome all of the family members and visitors who join us for Easter. This is the greatest celebration of our faith, and we are honored to have you with us. If any visitors are looking for a Church family, we would love to hear from you.

We received a gracious note of thanks from the Christ Child Society for our parish participation in their baby bottle collection. We contributed \$6,500 this year. This will help many new moms and atrisk children in our community.

We also received a card with Easter blessings from St. Mary's Seminary in Fort Portal, Uganda. As part of our parish tithe, we sent \$7,700 in December. They sent photos as well as receipts to show

how they had used the money. They bought Liturgy of the Hours prayer books, 30 classroom desks (3-seaters), and large quantities of beans and maize flour for their meals. Their photos include a picture of young seminarians proudly sitting in the new desks. I will post the pictures in the Gathering Space. (If I can figure out how to do it, I will also scan some photos and include them in my pastor's column on our website, stcharlesfw.org.)



Divine Mercy Plenary Indulgence

<u>In 2002, St. John Paul II</u> established the Sunday after Easter as the Feast of Divine Mercy and offered a plenary indulgence on this day. Once sins are forgiven in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, a plenary indulgence then removes the temporal punishment for those sins. We can gain an indulgence for



ourselves, or we can offer the indulgence for a soul in purgatory, helping them on their way to the glories of heaven. This can be the chance to offer the greatest of gifts to a loved one who has gone before us.

Requirements for the indulgence: 1) Make a sincere confession within 20 days before or after the feast day. 2) Receive Holy Communion at a Feast Day Mass. 3) offer prayers for the intention of Pope Francis. 4) Approach this with a complete detachment from sin. ST. CHARLES USHERS MINISTRY A CALL FOR HELP

The Usher Ministry needs volunteers to fill current openings. Over time, with normal attrition, the number of usher openings has grown to the current state, where we have about 20 openings spread out over most Mass times. We're asking for parishioner help to fill gaps in this important service ministry at St Charles.

The duties are not difficult and, for the most part, are accomplished during the normal Sunday Mass times (e.g. welcoming and seating attendees, offertory collections, guiding attendees during communion, bulletin distribution, etc). We try to place volunteers into their normal Sunday Mass schedules. We encourage families to use this ministry to introduce children to service ministry at the parish. Volunteers serve on usher teams that rotate on a 5 month schedule (i.e. 1 month on with 4 months off). Schedules are flexible when needed absences occur during the assigned month.
