**A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!**

This weekend we are celebrating First Holy Communion with a Sunday afternoon Mass at the Cathedral. This is an important day in the lives of our young parishioners. Please remember them in prayer.

We will have a discernment meeting this week for new members of our Parish Council. The council meets monthly on Wednesday evenings to talk about the spiritual life, social life, and outreach of our parish. If you would be interested, please let me know. Fr. James has a brother who is a Priest, stationed in Philadelphia. The parish in Philadelphia has Mass in an Indian language and using an Indian rite, which is a little different from our liturgy. Fr. James is now in Philadelphia covering Masses, giving his brother a chance to visit family in India. Not many priests in this country would be able to cover that parish! Fr. James will return on May 13.

I will make a trip to Indianapolis on Saturday for the graduation of Noah Isch, who is graduating from Blessed Simon Brute College Seminary. Next year, Noah will join Jake Schneider and Sam Martinez at Mount St. Mary Seminary in Maryland. We are blessed to have three diocesan seminarians in our parish, as well as Jacob Eifrid studying for Holy Cross and Brother Marius Roy, studying with the Carthusians in Vermont. We continue to pray for religious vocations—and especially asking for young women who will hear the call to religious life. Jake Schneider will be ordained a Deacon in South Bend on May 21, and will preach his first homily here at St. Charles on May 22, at the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses.

Renovation, Week 16. We are hoping for a May 31 completion, and we have the Bishop scheduled for a Mass in the church that evening. We are still awaiting delivery of a number of items and we don't have guarantees on delivery times. Our builders are sounding more optimistic as each week goes by. We are hopeful for a big event on May 31.


This week, the marble stand under the tabernacle was completed and the tabernacle was mounted in place. Before the tabernacle stand was sealed shut, we went to our parish funeral records and typed a 13-page list of everyone who has had a St. Charles funeral from 1957 to the present. We now have a list of 2,272 loved ones who have been a part of this parish and have gone before us permanently sealed below the tabernacle. Included with their names is a prayer: "Lord, we ask for your mercy on these, our faithful departed. As they have shared their faith with us, we now lift them in prayer. Bring them to the Kingdom of Heaven and let your light shine upon them." Our loved ones are remembered and they still join us at Holy Mass.


