Dr. Jensen, who recently turned 90 has performed three times at The Cathedral of Notre Dame in Paris; at The National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington; The Riverside Church in New York City; and The Mormon Tabernacle in Salt Lake City, among many other notable locations in the United States and world-wide. She has also been invited to play next year at The Cathedral of St. John the Divine in New York City.

Dr. Jensen has served on the organ faculties of Indiana-University in Bloomington, and Scarritt Graduate School in Nashville. Tennessee where she was a teacher to our Co-Director of Music. Tim Robison. In addition, for over 20 years, she served as Organist/Choirmaster at St. George's
