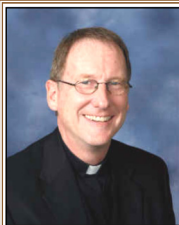

## A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR . . .

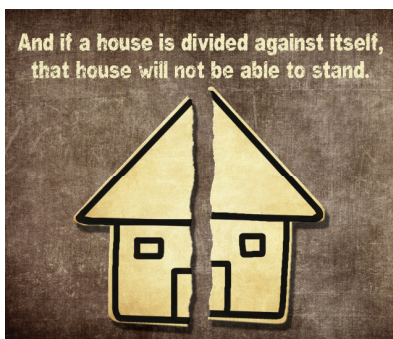

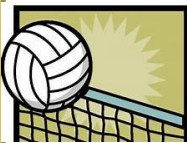

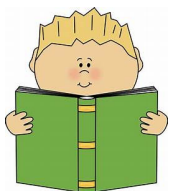
