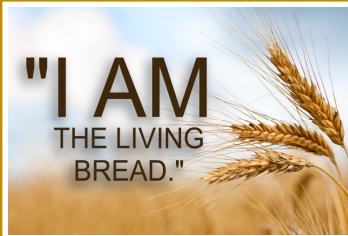

**A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR**

We are celebrating a First Communion Mass on Saturday this weekend and we will celebrate another next Saturday. We have limited seating so that we can spread out, but we would like to have our whole parish praying for these children. This is an important parish event. We are planning to livestream for family members who cannot attend.

Redeemer Radio is holding a virtual Sharathon from June 11-15 from 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. Since we missed the March Sharathon, this is a good chance to support our Catholic radio station. Tune in to 106.3 FM or go to the website [redeemerradio.com](http://redeemerradio.com) to make a donation. Many of us have grown in our faith by listening to Catholic radio. Let's support our station.

You may want to check out the beautiful prayer garden between our school and our youth house. In addition to the statue of the Blessed Mother with trellis and well-tended landscaping, we have now mounted to the school wall the stainless steel cross which was taken down from our church last year. This cross stood on top of our old church from 1958 until 1975 and was moved to the new church when it opened in 1975. For 61 years, that cross shone out as a witness in our neighborhood. Now it is in a more secluded space. At the base of the cross you will find ten round stepping stones, designed for praying a decade of the rosary. We offer thanks to the Martinez family for all of their work in landscaping and making this garden beautiful.

We continue to livestream our 11:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday mornings. It is easy to find this Mass: simply go to our parish website, [stcharlesfortwayne.org](http://stcharlesfortwayne.org) and you will see the two obvious clicks. The first weekend that we aired, the links disappeared at 11:01 and latecomers couldn't find it. We think we have that problem resolved. My 89-year-old mother is not known for her computer skills, but she found it easily on her own. If you are elderly or at risk for the corona virus, the livestream is a completely safe option to join us in Mass and Spiritual Communion.

Next weekend is Father's Day. We give thanks to God for our fathers and all of the men who have been important influences in our lives.

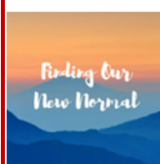

**SCHEDULE NOTE** – Mark your calendars for the following schedule changes. In observance of the **4<sup>th</sup> of July**, there are no **SCRIP** sales **July 3 – July 5**. Friday morning sales in the Hession Center will take place on Thursday, July 2 and the office will be open again on Monday, July 6.



It appears that we are slowly finding our "new normal." People are slowly returning to Mass and we saw a few more people at our **SCRIP** table last week. That being said COVID numbers in Allen County are still high and so the need to continue careful social distancing, wearing masks and washing your hands is still important.

In the **SCRIP** office we are doing our very best to be safe for you as well as ourselves. If you are not ready to venture out, simply call the office with your order. We will fill it and you can pick it up at the front door of the Parish Office, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Most days, the SCRIP Office is open from 8:30 a.m. – noon. If we don't answer, it might be that we are on another line or that we stepped out of the office for a minute. Simply leave your order on the answering machine with a phone number. We will fill the order and let you know that it is ready.

Friday morning sales in the Hession Center have resumed with our summer hours of 8:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. We are also available on the weekends – Saturdays after the 5:00 p.m. Mass and Sundays from 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.

If you are grocery shopping or filling your gas tank, you should consider doing it with **SCRIP** gift cards. If you are shopping on-line, picking up food from your favorite drive thru restaurant or if sheltering in place inspired a home improvement project, all of those things can be done with **SCRIP!**

**Last But Not Least** - COVID has impacted the church's budget as hard as it has impacted our budgets. **SCRIP** is a great way to help us get back on track. If you have not used it or don't use it as much as you did in past, this would be a great time to start.
