

VERY IMPORTANT MESSAGE HOSPITAL VISITING MINISTRY

REMINDER If you or a family member are admitted to any of our local hospitals, and especially if you are admitted through the Emergency Room, and would like St. Charles notified, **you must inform the hospital staff that it is permissible to contact your parish church.** The Privacy Act requires that names are not given to the **Hospital Visiting Ministry** unless permission has been given by the patient or family. You **must** volunteer this information - they will not ask. **A family member may also call the Parish Office with this information.**

Each family may schedule only four Masses per year. (Five if you schedule a 6:15 a.m.) Of those four, only one may be a Saturday/Sunday or Holy Day Mass. The other three may be scheduled on weekdays.

Two or more names may be submitted for one Mass if they are related. (i.e. father/son; husband/wife; living and deceased of the John Smith & Sam Jones Families).

According to Canon Law, the Bishops of a Province determine the offering amount that seems appropriate. The Bishops of Indiana Province have determined that the appropriate offering is \$10.00 per Mass.

SCRIP NEWS

Using SCrip now! - If going to the lake or traveling are your favorite parts of summer, then you probably find it hard to purchase **SCRIP** in the summer. Now you can continue to purchase **SCRIP**, wherever you are, using **Great Lake's** online program – **ScripNow.**

You can shop online and purchase **e-certificates** to many participating merchants, making it possible to continue to earn rebates on many of your purchases wherever you are. It's not just for traveling, I find it useful when I want to make a purchase from my armchair in the evening on Amazon or William Sonoma. If my family decides to go to the movies, I can go online and purchase e-certificates so that we earn rebates on our tickets and snacks. You never have to miss out on rebates again with **ScripNow.** Talk to one of the **SCRIP** ladies to get started.



iTunes Cards – Recent news about Apple's media programs made us a little nervous about buying and selling iTunes cards. So we did a little research and this is what we found:

Apple is killing the iTunes app on the Mac in favor of three new apps in macOS Catalina this fall: Apple TV, Apple Music and Apple Podcasts.

- But your music library will remain intact right in Apple Music, Apple says. You'll still be able to use iTunes gift cards to buy content, too.
- On Windows, iTunes will still survive. The changes mostly only effect MAC owners.

SCRIP Potential – I often look for examples to help our parishioners realize what their earning potential might be using SCRIP. This week on the news they were giving tips on how to save at the grocery store. In the report they estimated that the average family of 4 spends \$875 - \$1,045/month on groceries. If those numbers are correct, that means an average family using SCRIP gift cards to pay for those groceries could generate a profit of as little as \$210 but as much as \$502 over a year. Half of that profit benefits St. Charles but the other half of that profit goes back to **you**, the customer! Wouldn't you like to put \$251 back in your pocket at the end of the year!
