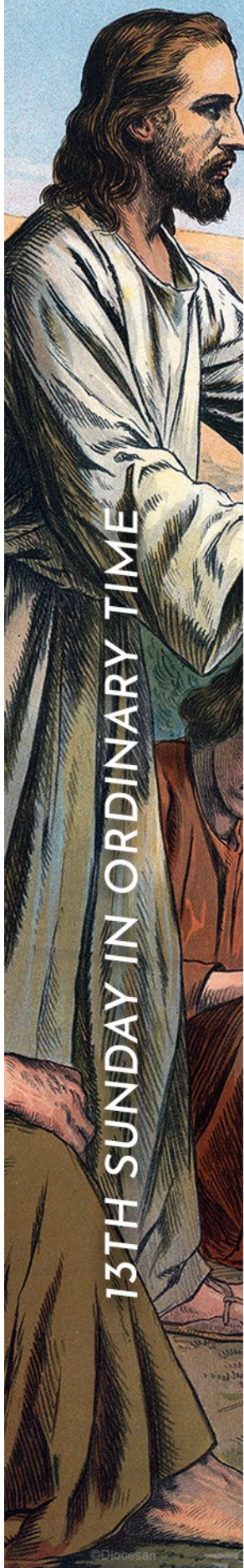

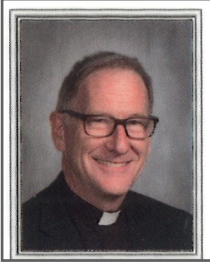

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR




On Friday, July 17, the Diocese is offering a “Day of Discernment with Priests and Seminarians.” Any young man, age 15-35, who might want to learn more about the Priesthood is invited to meet at Chain O’ Lakes State Park for a day of discussion, kayaking, hiking and a cookout lunch. We are happy to see the city improving our streets and sidewalks, and I am impressed by the amount of work going on in Fort Wayne this summer—surely a sign of a city that is serious about maintaining our neighborhoods. Next weekend, we will celebrate the 4th of July with special zeal, remembering the 250th Anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Our office will be closed on Friday the 3rd and we will offer special prayers for our nation at the Saturday morning Mass.

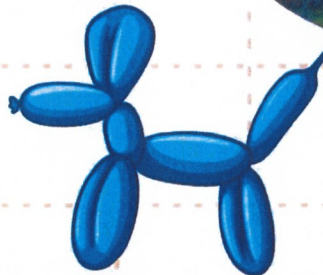

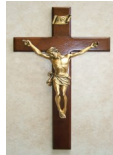
