

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

For two years now our parish has been twinning with a seminary in Fort Portal, Uganda. Last year we sent almost \$8,000. They purchased wooden desks for the seminary along with bags of rice and beans for the seminarians' meals. We received very

grateful letters in return along with photos and receipts from their purchases. This year we sent \$11,000 to help them with a building project. The seminary had begun construction of a two-story classroom building some years ago but never finished it due to lack of funds. Our gift should be enough to finish the building. We are now receiving photos with gracious notes of thanks as they are working on this project. I will post photos on the parish website. Go to stcharlesfw.org, click on Menu, then Pastor's Column, then July 5, and you will find photos. You will see homemade scaffolding and piles of sand used to stucco the outside and inside of the building. This is the simplest of buildings.... homemade bricks covered in stucco with no plumbing or electricity. I think that St. Charles, the patron saint of seminaries, would be tickled to see what our donation is doing. If anyone would like to make a further donation to help, you may write a check to St. Charles and we will send a bank transfer.

Fr. Thomas is on a drive to Missouri this weekend, meeting up with a couple of seminary friends. This is a little vacation scheduled before the transfer was scheduled.

FROM THE ORGAN BENCH

On the weekend of June 20-21, the entrance hymn at the 5 PM, 7:30 and 9:00 AM Masses was one of the great hymns of the Church, "Praise to the Lord, the Almighty." Based on words from 103 and 150, the German composer, Joachim Neander composed this hymn in 1680. The prelude and postlude were both based on this hymn. The setting of the prelude was by Johann G. Walther, a German musician who lived at nearly the same time as Johann Sebastian Bach and who also happened to be his cousin. The postlude was by Hans F. Micheelsen, a contemporary German composer and church musician who lived from 1902 to 1973.

The prelude and postlude for June 27-28, was the Prelude and Fugue in C Major by Johann Sebastian Bach. Bach composed many preludes and fugues during his life and this one is a part of his eight "little" preludes and fugues. The pieces in this collection are shorter and less complex than many of Bach's organ works but still stand on their own as wonderful pieces to learn, play, and listen to.
