#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Friendliness and hospitality are deliberate goals of our parish. We especially want newcomers and visitors to feel welcome here and to sense that this would be a good church to call home. That is precisely the reason that our Gathering Space was built. The Gathering Space is a great location for welcoming people, visiting, organizing parish activities, and getting to know each other.

Since we do now have an ideal place for visiting, we would like to maintain quiet in the church. Many people come for quiet prayer before and after Masses. Let's do our best to respect their prayer time, keeping the church quiet and moving conversations out to the Gathering Space.

If you know Catholics who aren't very active in practicing their faith, we have a wonderful opportunity with *Alpha*. *Alpha* is a ten-week course that shares the beauty of our faith, stressing the relationship with Jesus. Our fall session of *Alpha* will be held on Wednesday evenings from September 18 until November 20, from 6:15 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Each evening includes a free dinner, a good video, and small group discussion. For parishioners who haven't yet taken part, I recommend it. I also encourage everyone to think of someone to invite. This is a chance to revitalize the faith.

St. Charles has a beautiful history of generosity in twinning with parishes in need. For many years we have given regular donations to three local parishes: St. Patrick, St. Henry and Queen of Angels. Two years ago we began an annual donation of \$25,000 a year to the seminarian tuition fund. Last year we added a seminary in Uganda to our parish twinning.

The bishop recently called, told me that St. Joseph Parish is having financial struggles, and asked if there was a chance that we could twin with them. I met with our parish Finance Committee and discussed dropping one of the other parishes in order to help St. Joseph. However, we decided that we are in a solid financial situation and we should increase our parish tithe. We are going to add St. Joseph to our list of donations.

These statements are available for pickup at the SCRIP sales table. The credit can then be redeemed for tuition credit at St. Charles, Bishop Dwenger, or any school where you are paying tuition, including preschools and colleges. They can be used for lunch accounts and extracurricular activities. They never expire, so they can be saved for the future for your younger children or grandchildren. There are lots of options. If you are uncertain which option is best for you, the SCRIP ladies will be happy to help you decide. The most important thing is, YOU EARNED IT, SO CLAIM IT!!! But, be sure to sign it before turning it in!
