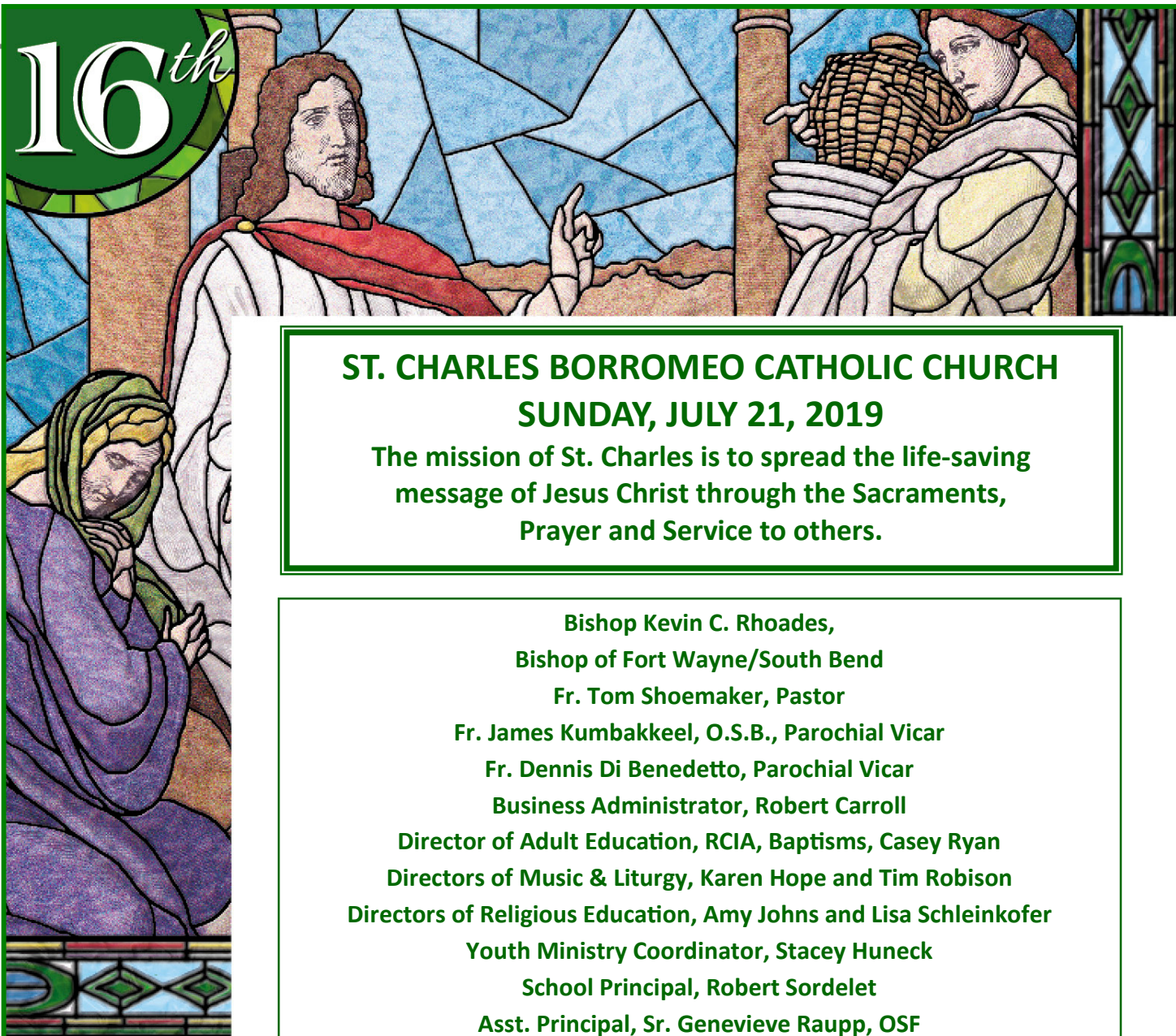

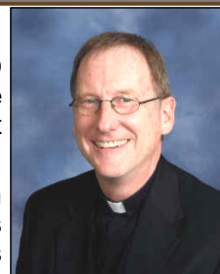
## A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

I point out information in this bulletin concerning SGO scholarships. Donations to the St. Charles SGO scholarship fund are especially useful for students and for donors as well. Many students become eligible for state tuition vouchers after receiving an SGO scholarship. For donors, an Indiana tax credit is offered for those who donate. Take a look.

In olden days, each family had one landline telephone in the home, and as long as the family lived in that home, the number remained consistent. Times have changed. With cell phones and e-mail, it is hard to keep up-to-date with contact information for parishioners. If you aren't sure that the parish has your current phone number or e-mail, we would love to hear from you.
