ST. CHARLES INDULGENCE GROUP

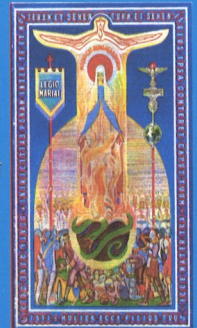

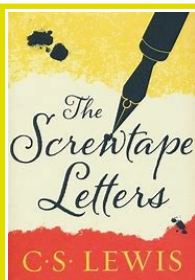
