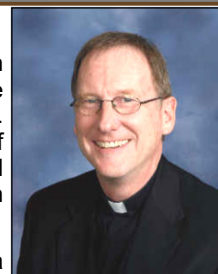

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Every year, the diocese asks us to host a missionary priest. This is our chance to learn a bit about the Church around the world and also to help support the Church in different parts of the globe. Next week, Fr. Peter Dee De will preach at all Masses and tell us about the Church in Burma/Myanmar. Fr. Peter is no stranger to St. Charles. He has been serving for several years at the Cathedral in Fort Wayne, where he has been a strong supporter of St. Charles School. He has encouraged many Catholic Burmese families to enroll their children in our school, and we call upon him to translate for parents when there is a language barrier. Please be as generous as you can with the collection.

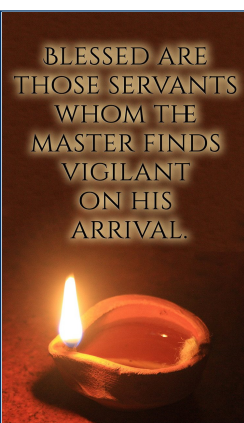


You may note two updates in the church building: First, we are working on the sound system. We have replaced a faulty mixer and we are working out the problems. Second, we have installed electric door openers on the bathrooms in the Gathering Space. We hope to prevent a repeat occurrence of a parishioner in wheelchair trapped in the bathroom.

Stop and admire the work that has been done on our parish landscaping this summer. Last weekend we had a crew of Knights of Columbus doing hard labor with a bobcat, shovels, saws and trimmers—removing tree stumps, dying shrubs and weeds along the north side of the school. I am grateful to the Knights and to all of the parish volunteers who are now at work on our grounds. The results are beautiful.

I received a letter last week from the American Guild of Organists, announcing that Tim Robison, our parish organist, has been named a Colleague of the guild. To earn this title, he had to take an exam, playing three specified organ pieces for judges, and then demonstrating ability in transposing, sight reading and improvisation. We are blessed to have a very talented organist at St. Charles.

ORGANISTS CONVERGE IN GRAND RAPIDS

The American Guild of Organists, founded in 1896 and now comprising more than 15,000 members, of which I am one of those, holds outstanding educational events, conferences, and conventions each year throughout the United States.

National conventions, held every other year take place in notable large cities of which I have had the opportunity to attend. Chicago, Houston, Kansas City, and Nashville are just a few of those.

This summer there were six regional conventions. The convention for the Great Lakes Region in which I attended was held in Grand Rapids, Michigan, and drew 300 organists and church musicians from five states for a week of outstanding organ playing by noteworthy organists from the United States and abroad. Grand Rapids has an unusually large number of fine pipe organs in churches of many denominations, as well as in other venues throughout the city.

There were two Catholic Churches featured during the week, both architecturally beautiful and containing fine pipe organs. Those were The Basilica of St. Adalbert and The Cathedral of St. Andrew.

It was an honor to represent our parish at the convention and to have the opportunity to hear such excellent organ playing from the finest organists!
