#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR ...



We celebrate this week the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven, a holy day of obligation. We have four opportunities for the holy day Mass: Tuesday evening at 6:30 p.m., and Wednesday at 6:15 a.m., 8:15 a.m., and 6:30 p.m.

We welcome our school children, teachers and faculty in this fresh new school year. You may remember from our parish history that our parish had a functioning *school* building before we had a functioning *church* building. The parish has always had a huge emphasis on educating our children and encouraging the growth of their Catholic faith.

I encourage everyone to consider *Alpha*, the faith-building program which will begin on Sept. 5, and follow for 10 Wednesday evenings. This is a chance to take a good look at our faith lives and to see and talk about what is really important. Each evening will begin with a catered dinner (at no cost), a video by Bishop Brynes and discussion. The parish sees this as such an important issue that we are paying the royalties to show the movie at no charge and we will invite parents from neighboring parishes as well. We are planning to show the movie in church on Sunday evening, October 7. We'll begin 15 minutes after the evening Mass. The movie is 67 minutes long. It is aimed at parents, but appropriate for children over age 10.
