August 15 is the Feast of the Assumption of Mary into Heaven. This is typically a Holy Day of Obligation, and since it falls on Sunday this year, the Feast of the Assumption takes precedence over our regular Sunday readings and prayers. While the feast points to Mary's fate, taken body and soul to live in the Kingdom of Heaven, it is

also a feast that points to our fate. If we follow the example of Mary, following the way of Jesus and accepting his mercy, we will one day also be taken body and soul to live in the Kingdom of Heaven. Help us, Lord, to follow that way.




