

We are celebrating a memorial Mass this weekend for Bob Weigand, who died during the early days of the virus scare and the liturgy shutdown. Through the years Bob and his construction company have been responsible for most of the construction of our school building, parish office, youth house and church. Our parish buildings will stand as a memorial.

DID YOU REGISTER YOUR CHILDREN FOR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION


