# FROM THE ORGAN BENCH

#### SCHOOL CHILDREN LEARN. "HYMN OF THE MONTH"

What is a "hymn?" A hymn is a song, typically religious in nature used for adoration and prayer. The word, "hymn" comes from an ancient Greek word (translated, "hymnos") which means, "song of praise." For centuries, followers of God have written hymns and have often compiled them into collections or even large books called, "hymnals." The hymnals we use here at St. Charles, WORSHIP (red), and GATHER (blue), contain well over 1000 different hymns combined!

Our school children over the last several years have learned a different new hymn each month termed, "Hymn of the Month." The chosen hymn for a specific month is taught in music classes in school, then sung each Friday during Mass that same month. Since this specific method was implemented, our school children have learned more than 50 new hymns!

The study of hymns or, "hymnody" is an interesting and wide-ranging topic. I will share even more information about hymns in upcoming bulletins. Stay tuned!


