
A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

LeeAllen Fortin, our summer seminarian, will be ordained to the diaconate next weekend. The ordination Mass will take place at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 4, at the Fort Wayne Cathedral. Everyone is invited. Especially for those who have never attended an ordination, I would encourage you to consider this one. This is

the one of our seven Sacraments which many Catholics have never observed. With the seating restrictions from the pandemic lifted and only one candidate being ordained, there should be no trouble getting a good seat. We expect that he will be ordained a priest in June.

We are honored that Deacon LeeAllen will preach his first homily at St. Peter's on Sunday morning and at St. Charles at our 5:00 p.m. Sunday evening Mass next weekend.

As we have read about the devastating earthquake in Haiti, our US bishops have asked us to take a collection to help. We will have that collection next weekend. We will put out baskets on the tables in the back of church, labeled "Haiti Earthquake Victims". 
