A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Monday is Labor Day, a national holiday when we honor all who do manual labor. We will have only one Mass on Monday, at 9:00 a.m.

Next Sunday will be our annual Cardinal Fest, shortened because of the pandemic, but a great parish event nonetheless. We will begin at noon with food trucks, Bingo, carnival

games and inflatables for kids. At 12:45 p.m. there will be a fun run for kids and at 1:30 p.m. a 5 kilometer run for the serious and the not-so-serious athletes. Mr. Sordelet and I will again try to cross the finish line without hurting ourselves.

Next weekend, we will show a video before Mass which will explain our renovation plans and present a lot of details. We will start the video at the normal Mass times and begin Mass afterward. (It is an 8 ½ minute video, similar in length to a Bishop's Appeal video.) We have launched a capital campaign, titled "Welcoming the Tabernacle" to cover the costs of renovation. You will hear more about this in the coming weeks and we will pass out pledge cards on the weekend of September 25/26. Our parish will not be asking for pledges for the Annual Bishop's Appeal this year. We will take the amount of our goal from the capital campaign so that we don't have to ask for money twice.

The renovation will begin on December 27, and we will need to close the church for a few months. Weekend Masses and school Masses will be moved to the gym, while the smaller daily Masses will be held in the Gathering Space. We will borrow churches from neighboring parishes for funerals during that span. Please stay healthy so we don't have to worry about that!

The artist who will be doing paintings for our renovation has sent some photos from her studio in St. Louis. She is in the preliminary stages, working on the pose for St. Charles and using a live model. I will attach photos on our website. After "Menu", click "Pastor's column" and you will see an interesting process.




