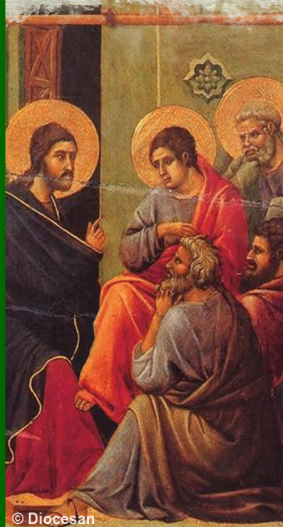

**A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR**

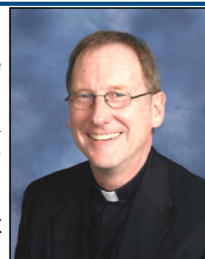

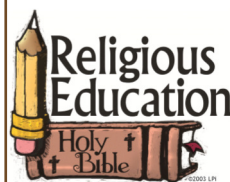

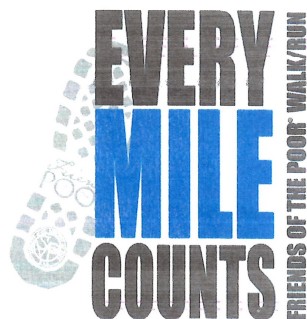
