

Our parish will not ask for money for the Bishop's Appeal this year. Whatever amount you usually give to the Bishop's Appeal would be a good starting point as you consider a pledge. (But please go beyond that. Our goal for this campaign is roughly 8 times the normal ABA goal!) You can make a pledge over 18 months.
