#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR.

We have a special event planned on All Soul's Day, Tuesday, November 2. At our 6:30 p.m. evening Mass, we will read the names of loved ones who have died since last November and we will light a candle in remembrance of each. (Our preliminary list includes all those who had funeral services from our parish. Please call us at 260-

482-2186 if you have a family member who died in the past year, if the funeral was not held in our parish and if you would like to take part in this Mass, we will be happy to add them to the list. The Mass will be broadcast on livestream for those unable to join us in person. Go to our parish website, stcharlesfortwayne.org, look under *Coming Events*, and click on *All Soul's Day Mass*.

You may or may not know that Catholic Charities is the largest agency in the nation helping to resettle refugees and exiles. Over the next month or two, approximately 75 of the people who were evacuated from Afghanistan are coming to Fort Wayne. Catholic Charities receives only two days notice when a family is arriving, and then scrambles to find housing, furniture and clothing. For the time being, we are loaning the use of our parish office garage to store furniture. We are looking for other ways for our parish to help.

Finally, as part of our parish tithe, St. Charles has been providing an annual gift to a seminary in Fort Portal, Uganda. We received last week a beautiful letter with photos and receipts showing how they had spent the funds. Most of our gift was used to buy beans and maize flour to feed their students and to pay electric bills. The corona virus hit their area hard and the seminary had to shut down in March of 2020. After calling students back, they had to shut down a second time in June of 2021 and send students home again. Unfortunately, the beans and flour can't be stored more than a few months and weevils destroyed much while the students were gone. They have kept some of their essential staff on half salary in order to take care of their gardens, their piggery, and to provide cleaning and security. With the economy in rough shape, they have had trouble with neighbors stealing their food and their pigs. They spent some of our funds on cement to build a periphery wall and keep thieves away. As a parish, we will send another check in the springtime, reflecting a small percentage of our parish offertory. If anyone would like to add to that, it would be welcome. A photo is attached.


