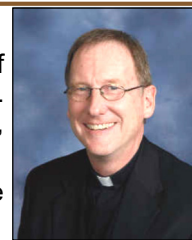
## A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

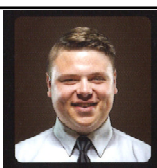

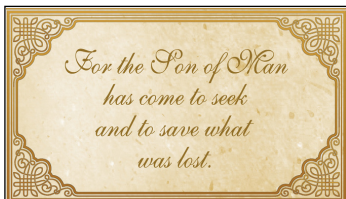

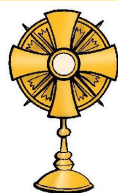
