

### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

The diocese is offering an 8-week online course for married couples, creatively titled *The Marriage Course Online*. The program is designed for married couples of all ages to better their communication skills and take a look at their relationship through the eyes of faith. It takes place on Thursday evenings from 8:00 p.m.-10:00 p.m. from February 4 to March 25. You will

As we are all anxious for an end to the pandemic, the vaccines are becoming available. As I write this column (last weekend), anyone over the age of 80 is eligible to make an appointment. At some point, those over 70 will be offered an appointment, followed by those over 60. I made the appointment for my mom; it is very simple. Go to ourshot.in.gov, give name and date of birth, and then pick out a time for an appointment.

This Saturday, January 23, the annual Fort Wayne March for Life, sponsored by Northeast Indiana Right to Life, is scheduled. A family member of the late abortion doctor in Fort Wayne has been lined up as the speaker. With COVID restrictions and crowd restrictions, the plans for this event are still uncertain as I write the bulletin. As I mentioned in a previous bulletin, we are preparing for a program spearheaded by Our Sunday Visitor, which will help us to look at our offertory giving. Church giving has dropped during the pandemic, and this is a good time for each of us to take a good look at our income, our spending, and our priorities as we consider how much we should give to the parish. There is no pressure with this program. Once we have determined how much we should give each year, we will be asked to fill out a commitment card. The commitment is our plan, not a legal or moral obligation. Stay tuned!

### ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY

The St. Charles Council of St. Vincent dePaul Society will meet on Monday, January 18, 2021 7:00 p.m. in the Hession Center, Room B. This will be an in-person meeting only. Our organization does many different corporal works of mercy, such as feeding the hungry and clothing the naked. If that is something that is important to you please plan to attend our next meeting to find out how you can lend a hand.

December was a very busy month for our organization. We were able to help 80 individuals consisting of 43 adults and 37 children. We provided \$ 2,406.51 in rent and utility payments, \$ 269.07 for medical bills, \$ 700.00 for furniture, and \$ 133.00 for food which provided 700 pounds of food. In addition, we give \$ 200.00 to St. Patrick's Parish to help an immigrant family for a total of \$3,706.38 to help the needy. In addition to our normal support of those in need we were also able to provide help for 23 families to enjoy Christmas. The 23 families included 31 adults and 51 children. Your generous donation of over \$ 6,000.00 for the Giving Tree made a wonderful difference for these families. We are so blessed to be a part of such a generous parish. Thank you and may God bless you all.




Registration forms are available at the school front desk. A copy of your birth certificate must accompany the registration.

## Pre-K4 & Kindergarten **Registration Coming Soon!**

January 19, 2021!
You are invited to our Kindergarten & Pre-Kindergarten registration day on Tuesday, January 19. Registration will be held in the afternoon from

1:15 p.m.-2:30 p.m. in Rooms C & D of the Hession Center, or you may attend the evening session from 6:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m. All parents are asked to park in the rear of the school in the church parking lot and enter through door # 3 near the gym. Wearing of a mask is required. If experiencing COVID symptoms, please call the school office (484-3392) to arrange for an alternate registration day.

**Kindergarten**: For this coming school year 2021-2022, we will be offering full-day Kindergarten with classroom size limits of 23 students per class with an aide assisting the teacher. Our school day runs from 7:50 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. If needed, for an additional fee, Beforecare and Aftercare service is available for all

Initial tuition costs are projected to be \$3,768 (\$314 per month over 12 months) for parishioners, and \$6,564 (\$547 per month over 12 months) for non-parishioners. The registration fee of \$50 is included in the overall tuition costs and is not a required payment at this time.

Pre-Kindergarten four-year-old Program: We will be offering two sections of five-day Pre-Kindergarten classes (A.M., P.M., or Full-day). Our morning program will run from 7:50 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. and our afternoon program will run from 11:50 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. The full-day program is 7:50 am - 3:00 pm.

Initial tuition costs are projected to be \$1,884 (\$157 per month over 12 months) per half-day, or \$3,768 (\$314 per month over 12 months) for the full-day program. A separate \$50 Pre-K registration fee is required.

Our January registration for our Kindergarten and Pre-K 4 Programs is early enough to ensure that parish families of St. Charles Borromeo have a first opportunity to register their children. Please bring to registration:

- 1. A copy of your child's birth certificate and baptismal certificate, even if baptized at St. Charles
- 2. A copy of your child's Social Security card
- 3. A copy of your child's immunization record
- 4. The \$50.00 nonrefundable registration fee

This is a very exciting time for our parents and young people. We want to ensure your child's school experience is a faith-filled, engaging, and supportive experience.
