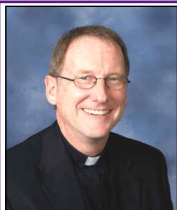

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

The three parish seminarians living in our rectory are offering a series of Wednesday evening virtual Advent talks at 7:00 p.m. each Wednesday in December. This Wednesday the topic will be Vocations and the Relationship with Jesus. Jake, Sam and Noah came up with this idea and took the initiative to make it happen.

On the topic of Facebook, it is not part of my world. In September, I tried to tune into the Redeemer Radio livestream event and it looked like I would have to use Facebook to do that. I tried to sign up but became confused and didn't follow through. Since then I've been getting notifications that people are trying to contact me or befriend me. Please do not be offended if you are one of those people and I am ignoring you. I'm not unfriendly, I'm just not a Facebook user.

Unfortunately, due to Covid concerns, the Knights of Columbus had to cancel their Advent Fish Fry last week, just as they had to cancel their Lenten Fish Fry in March. Unfortunately, too, since Thanksgiving caused an early bulletin deadline for last week's bulletin, I didn't get the cancelation notice in time to withdraw the plug in the bulletin. I hope that we didn't have a lineup of cars filled with hungry people in our parking lot last weekend.

We received a letter from St. Patrick's Food Pantry, thanking us for the tremendous amount of food donated in our food drive. They said that it will "help immensely as we feed the people in our parish and neighborhood." I would say these donations are probably our best Christmas gifts.

A reminder of our Christmas Mass schedule: We have Masses on Christmas Eve at 4:00 p.m., 6:30 p.m., and Midnight. On Christmas morning, Masses are 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. We continue to require masks, to maintain distancing, and to sanitize the church after each Mass. Expecting that we may have crowds, we are planning to offer 4:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. Christmas Eve Masses both in the church and in the gym at the same time. For those who are at risk and afraid of the virus, the Mass obligation has been lifted. There will be plenty of opportunities to join a livestream Mass.
