

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

This weekend, in one weekend, we are celebrating Mary, the Mother of God; the New Year; and Epiphany. With all this taking place, it will also be our first weekend in the gym. We ask for patience as we try to work out all of the kinks involved in setting up the gym, figuring out the sound system, printing

worship aids, and a hundred other details. By May, we will be good at this. A reminder: From now until the end of May, all Saturday evening and Sunday Masses and all school Masses will be held in the gym. Come to the Hession Center, Door 3. The rest of our daily Masses will be held in the Gathering Space of the Church, and confessions will remain in the Bride's Room and Nursery in the Church.

We are especially grateful to the church decorators this year. Knowing that Christmas decorations would have to be removed from the church on December 26, our decorators insisted that Christmas was too important to skimp on the decorations. We are also grateful to musicians who have adapted to Christmas without a pipe organ and are now working out the plans for Masses in the gym.

A good idea was very recently presented, which we are adding to our church renovation project. The windows in our church are high and hard to reach. They make for a bright and sunny church, but there is a problem at a certain time of the morning when the priest is blinded by the light in his eyes. When the church was built, the architect had a solution to the problem: curtains were installed in the windows, opened and closed with electric motors hidden above the ceiling. While the solution has been effective through the years, those motors are now 46 years old, hard to access, and several no longer work. As an addition to the renovation plan, we are going to remove the curtains and motors and put in new windows with tinted glass. The tint will let in plenty of light but subdue the glare of the morning sun.

Before Christmas, we had work done to protect our pipe organ from dust during the renovation. The same company which built and installed the organ came from Kansas to do the work. It has been very interesting to learn more about the construction of this very complex instrument. The organ console is now stored in our Community Room, and we have 84 of the large pipes stored safely in the rectory basement. There are roughly 2000 pipes total. The majority of the pipes remain in the church, located inside two wooden chambers which are now protected with plastic sheets. I am including a photo to give an idea of the complexity of this instrument.


"This Week in RCIA"






