

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We had a beautiful Christmas this year. The music was inspiring, the church was beautiful, and best of all, our attendance was up. Four of our five Masses were bigger than last year and our total count for Communion was up by 400 people. This surely is a gift to the newborn Lord.

I offer a few words about the document which came from the Vatican just before Christmas. I'm convinced that much of the anger, the excitement, and the debate surrounding this document comes from people who haven't read the document. The pope does not suggest any change in moral teaching on sexuality. Sexual activity is sacred within a sacramental marriage when husband and wife are acting in love and are open to new life. Sexual activity in any other context is wrong. While I think the document could be clearer by explicitly spelling out that point (in case the Pope ever asks my opinion), what is endorsed is not the blessing of a same-sex union, but instead blessing people who happen to be in such unions. The document is specific that priests need to avoid blessing a samesex couple in a way that looks like a liturgical blessing or a sacramental blessing of the union. If two men come to me after Mass asking for a blessing before they travel, I would give such a blessing regardless of their state of life. If two women come to me at the office asking for a blessing because they need patience in dealing with a difficult neighbor, I would give such a blessing. The document, entitled Fiducia Supplicans, is available online for those who want to read it.

This year's **Rekindle the Fire Men's Conference** will take place on Feb. 24 at the Memorial Coliseum. It will be a great day, featuring Bishop Rhoades and three fine speakers, with Mass, confessions, and time for Adoration. For more information or to reserve tickets, check the brochures on the tables at the back of church or go to rekindlethefire.net. This is a great opportunity for men who want to go a little deeper with their lives of faith.

Finally, a Christmas card was sent to the St. Charles Parish Family from the Poor Clare Sisters in Kokomo. Sister Maria Laetitia (formerly Sister Rose Caritas and formerly Karen Robertson) was a parishioner here before she joined the cloistered monastery. Life in the monastery includes the community praying the Liturgy of the Hours together seven times a day, Holy Mass, a Daily Rosary and Eucharistic Adoration. "In between, we can be found doing the ordinary tasks we share with so many of you: cooking, cleaning, laundry, washing windows and dishes, freezing corn and canning beans, apples and tomatoes." The sisters offer prayers and gratitude for our parish.





Dear Friend of St. Charles Borromeo Parish & School,

We are pleased to announce that the 6th annual Borromeo Bash will be held on Saturday, February 3, 2024 at Ceruti's. This past February, as a school and parish community, we gathered together for a delightful evening of food and fellowship, while successfully raising over \$72,000. Thank you to all, who through your generosity and kindness, have continued to support the needs of our school's students, faculty, staff and all our parishioners!

Borromeo Bash, through your kindness, has raised approximately \$385,000 over the past five years. We have also been blessed that many of our planned projects utilized matching funds or additional grants from an influx of State and/or Federal funds received during the Covid years. This unforeseen funding led to projects being completed at lower than

expected costs to the parish. The computer lab, improved security system, high efficiency lighting, and more - all would not have been possible without the Borromeo Bash. Instead of spending frivolously, the Borromeo Bash Committee held onto the funds until we could properly channel money towards other needed projects - for instance, after an unforeseen delay last year, new school windows are finally in the works!

Our current BB balance sits at just over \$235,000, of which, with additional funds from BB 2024 in February, we hope to put \$250,000 towards the school window replacement project, then turn further attention and proceeds towards a school restroom refreshening/renovation. As good stewards of your generosity, we are committed to helping the school and Parish grow with an eye towards the future.

Fr. Tom has contracted with MARTINRILEY architects • engineers (MRae) to replace all the circa 1970s curtain wall systems with a modern and more energy-efficient wall system. We would like to increase the amount of vision glass within each classroom and have at least one operable window for egress in each classroom. The preliminary construction budget range, based upon previous proposals, will run from \$600,000 -\$900,000 for all windows replaced along the main hallway from the office to the end of junior high. The proposed schedule of work and deadlines for the Window Replacement/Façade Update are as follows:

- Field Work and Data Collection Mid-October 2023 Begun
- Schematic Design with Owner Early November 2023
- 90% Review with Owner Early December 2023
- Construction Documents 100% Complete Late December 2023
- Invitation to Bid Early January 2024
- Pre-Bid Meeting Mid-January 2024
- **Bid Opening Late January 2024**
- Construction Start Beginning Summer Break 2024
- Construction Substantially Complete End of Summer Break 2024
