A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

After one weekend of Masses in the gym, we have learned some lessons. First, we can accommodate more chairs than expected. We have a lot of bleacher seating, but we can seat around 300 people on chairs. Second, the sound system is pretty good but rather complicated for us priests. There are six on/off switches for the system plus mute buttons for every microphone. (At two Masses last weekend we missed a couple of switches, leaving some people straining to hear.) Third, we have an attractive gym and we have adaptable people. Though there were a few rough edges, we had beautiful liturgies in the gym. We are a parish in exile, counting down the weeks until we can return to a beautiful sanctuary.

A word from St. Patrick's Food Pantry: "Please extend our gratitude to the parishioners for their kind toiletry gifts from the Giving Tree. We were overwhelmed with the ample amount we received, four carloads! What a wonderful outpouring of kindness! Also, thank the parishioners for the continued support for the food and gift cards that we receive weekly for our Food Pantry. Their help has been constant and so gracious."

I offer thanks to the many people who helped with the stripping of our church on the Sunday evening after Christmas. We had a large crowd of people eager to help and it went much faster than expected. Our church was left looking very bare, but clean and ready for construction workers.

I plan to offer a weekly status report on progress of the renovation. Keep in mind that I write my pastor's column the weekend before the bulletins are distributed in church. If you want more current news, go to the parish website and click on **Menu**, then *Pastor's Column*.

At the end of **Construction Week One**, you will see large metal storage units on the lawn next to our junior high classrooms. Pews are being loosened from the floor, removed from the church, and taken to those units for storage. I attached a photo of pews stacked in the storage units. The carpet is being cut out in pieces and markers are being dilled into the cement floor to indicate the position of pews and wires for the hearing loop. The wooden corpus for the crucifix has arrived from Germany. The marble from Italy is still on a ship in transit, hopefully, heading down the St. Lawrence Seaway and into the Great Lakes.

Pre-K4 & Kindergarten Registration at St. Charles Coming Soon! January 18, 2022!

I wish to invite you to our Kindergarten & Pre-Kindergarten registration day on Tuesday, January 18. Registration will be held in the afternoon from 1:15 p.m.- 2:30 p.m. in Rooms C & D of the Hession Center, or you may attend the evening session from 6:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m. All parents are asked to park in the rear of the school in the church parking lot and enter through door # 3 near the gym. Wearing of a mask is optional. If experiencing COVID symptoms, please call the school office (484-3392) to arrange for an alternate registration day.

Kindergarten: For this coming school year 2022-2023, we will be offering full-day Kindergarten with a classroom size limit of 23 students per class with an aide assisting the teacher. Our school day runs from 7:50 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. If needed, for an additional fee, Beforecare and Aftercare service is available for all students. The registration fee of \$50 is included in the overall tuition costs and is not a required payment at this time.

Pre-Kindergarten four-year-old Program: We will be offering two sections of five-day Pre-Kindergarten classes (A.M., P.M., or Full-day). Our morning program will run from 7:50 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. and our afternoon program will run from 11:50 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. A separate \$50 Pre-K registration fee is required.

Our January registration for our Kindergarten and Pre-K 4 Programs is early enough to ensure that parish families of St. Charles Borromeo have a first opportunity to register their children. Please bring to registration:

1. A copy of your child's Social Security card, birth certificate and baptismal certificate even if baptized at St. Charles
2. A copy of your child's immunization record
3. The \$50.00 nonrefundable registration fee (PreK)

This is a very exciting time for our parents and young people. We want to ensure your child's school experience is a faith-filled, engaging, and supportive experience. I thank you for your time, and I look forward to having your child with us next year. 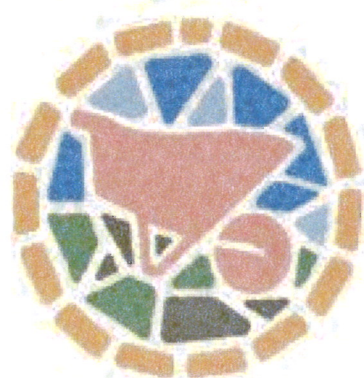

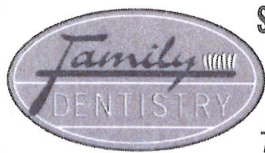
