



A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



With deadlines for our bulletin printing and shipping, this is the first Pastor's Column written by the Pastor after the Christmas Masses on December 25. We had a beautiful celebration here at St. Charles and I am grateful to everyone who contributed.... our priests for long hours of confessions, our deacons for beautiful homilies, our decorators for a lovely church, our musicians for glorious music, our ministers for providing livestreams and Communion to the homebound, and for all who brought friends and relatives.

We were surprised this year by enormous crowds at the 4:00 Mass on Christmas Eve. We placed about 250 chairs in the church and Gathering Space. Still, we couldn't come close to providing seats for the crowd this year and we had people who didn't even get inside the doors into the Gathering Space. The count of those receiving Holy Communion was 300 higher than last year. I have no idea where everyone parked. Some parishes resort to having two simultaneous Masses, one in the church and one in the gym on Christmas Eve. I don't like the idea of a Christmas Mass in the gym, but it might be a future discussion. I see this as a good problem, the kind of problem a parish is happy to face.

We have come to the beginning of a new year, it is a time when most of us are looking at finances and thinking about taxes. Our parish gives a 10% tithe on our offertory income to charities and parishes in need. While the parish is looking at our charitable giving, this is also a good time for each of us to consider our personal charitable giving. Like many parishioners, I try to tithe on my income. With annual pay raises, that means recalculating my donations each year. For those like me who make regular parish donations directly from a bank savings or checking account, call on Cece in our parish office and she can start or stop the donations and change the amount at any time. There is also an easy click on our parish website, *Online Giving*. While there is a 3% service fee for online giving, it is also a quick and easy way to make gifts to the parish.



St. Charles Borromeo School Pre-K4 & Kindergarten Registration

St. Charles Borromeo School Pre-K4 and Kindergarten registration day is Wednesday, January 14. Registration will be held in the afternoon from 1:15 p.m. - 2:30 p.m. in Rooms C & D of the Hession Center, or you may attend the evening session from 6:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. All parents are asked to park in the rear of the school in the church parking lot and enter through door # 3 near the gym. If unable to attend, please call the school office (260-484-3392) to arrange for an alternate registration day.

Kindergarten: For this coming school year 2026-2027, full-day Kindergarten is available with a classroom size limit of 24 students per class with an aide assisting the teacher. The school day runs from 7:50 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. If needed, for an additional fee, BeforeCare and AfterCare service is available for all students. The registration fee of \$50 is included in the overall tuition costs and is not a required payment at this time.

Pre-Kindergarten four-year-old Program: We offer five-day Pre-K4 classes (A.M., P.M., or Full-Day). Our morning program runs from 7:50 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. and our afternoon program runs from 11:50 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. A separate \$50 Pre-K registration fee is required.

The January registration for Kindergarten and Pre-K4 programs is early enough to ensure that parish families of St. Charles Borromeo have a first opportunity to register their children.

Please bring to registration:

1. A copy of your child's birth certificate
2. A copy of your child's baptismal certificate even if baptized at St. Charles
3. A copy of your child's immunization record
4. **Pre-K4 only:** \$50 non-refundable registration fee (cash or check only)




