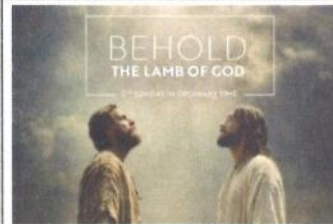

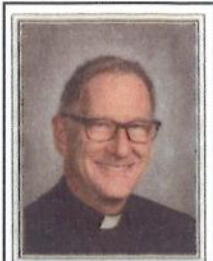

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Bishop Rhoades invites us to a prayer service this Sunday evening, January 18, at 5:00 p.m. at St. Jude. It will be an ecumenical prayer service, with people from many different Protestant denominations joining Catholics in prayer. As we are beginning a week of prayer for Christian unity, this is a good

chance to join with our Bishop and with friends and neighbors who are not fully united in our faith practices, praying for unity.

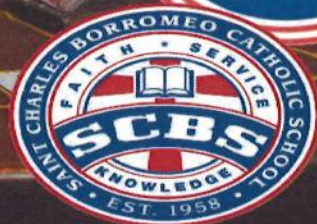
