A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

SCRIP Credit Statements are now available for pickup. This report shows the money you earned from purchasing SCRIP. Please stop by the table in the Gathering Space after all masses this weekend, January 20-21, for pickup. Even if you haven't purchased SCRIP in a while, please stop by the table and check if you have any unclaimed funds. We have researched our records and found some outstanding credits from the past.

You will need to sign the report and turn it back in <u>immediately</u>. Due to the closing, you can no longer save credit statements for the future. Remember, your portion of the money can be used for many different things, such as school tuition and lunch accounts, donating it to the St. Vincent DePaul Society, Capital Improvement Fund, or other parish ministries. If you do not want to use your credits for these options, you may request a refund in the form of a family rebate check.

If you don't have a chance this weekend, you can pick up your credit statement at the Parish Office between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on weekdays. However, if we do not receive the signed report by March 31, 2024, we will be required to turn the money over to the State of Indiana as unclaimed funds.






