



#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent. Ashes will be distributed at all Masses: 6:15 a.m., 8:15 a.m., 12:30 p.m., and 6:30 p.m. [We will have an all-school Mass at 8:15 a.m.; if you don't like crowds, you will want to choose another Mass.] Ash Wednesday is a day to fast, abstain from meat,

and make time for prayer. All of the Fridays of Lent, we are also asked to abstain from meat. The ashes on Ash Wednesday remind us that we are a sinful people, headed toward the grave. We need to reflect upon that before we are ready to celebrate the glories of Easter and what has been won for us.

On the Fridays of Lent, our 6:30 p.m. Mass will be followed by Stations of the Cross and Benediction, beginning at 7:00 p.m. Stations of the Cross will also be offered on the Sundays of Lent at 3:00 p.m. On the Wednesdays of Lent, we will have morning teaching and discussion about the Eucharistic Prayer in the Community Room, off of the church Gathering Space, following 8:15 a.m. Mass. On the Saturdays of Lent, we have a group of parishioners offering teachings on Catholic Apologetics. Those sessions will begin at 9:30 a.m., also in the Community Room. Lent needs to be a time set apart. We are preparing ourselves for the great events of Holy Week.

You will note liturgical differences during Lent. The Gloria disappears, along with every use of the word "Alleluia." Flowers are not allowed around the altar and the decoration of the church is stark. We will continue our parish custom of finishing the Mass in silence, spending a few moments in quiet prayer after the priest is gone.

We are fast approaching our parish 40 Hours Devotion. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed in the church from 7:00 p.m. on Sunday February 25, until 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 27. We will need to have people in the church during that time, night and day. A sign-up sheet is found in the back of church and also on our parish website. Please consider committing to an hour or two that you could spend with the Lord. Fr. Patrick Mary Briscoe, a gifted young Dominican priest who grew up at St. Charles and attended our parish school, will speak at all of the Masses on the weekend of February. 24/25 and he will speak at Evening Prayer at 7:00 p.m. on Sunday and Monday, and a Mass at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday.

Our parish Catholic Relief Society chapter will be passing out Rice Bowls after Masses this weekend. The Rice Bowl collection is the effort of the US Catholic Church to help areas of poverty overseas.

Registration has just opened for a young adult weekend retreat called *Summit Awakening*. The dates are June 14-16. Information is found on the diocesan website. Click on *Ministries* and then *Young Adult Ministry*.





The Advent Giving Tree donations provided many diapers, clothing, gift cards, laundry detergent and other baby items that will be used to continue serving mothers in need in 2024. 


