A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

Lent is about to begin. Ash Wednesday is a week from this Wednesday, on March 2. We will have four Masses on Ash Wednesday: 6:15 a.m., 8:15 a.m., 9:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. All four Masses will be celebrated in the gym. Now is a good time to start making plans for Lent. How can I grow in my faith? What extra can I do for others? What sins

or bad habits can I work to eliminate?

The Stations of the Cross will be offered each Friday evening in Lent in the Gathering Space of the Church. While there are no pictures on the walls, we do have booklets with the pictures featured.

We are planning a three-part Lenten Enrichment program this year, but please note that in our eagerness, we are beginning before Lent. The first presentation is this Thursday evening, Feb. 24, at 7:00 p.m. in the Hession Center. I will give a presentation on *The Eucharist in Art*. We will take a look at paintings and listen to music relating to the Eucharist. We will talk about the lessons we can learn from the art, and then use the art to draw us into prayer. The following Thursday, March 3, Fr. Koehl will speak on the virtue of hope through the teachings of St. Thomas Aquinas. The series will end on March 10, with Casey Ryan offering a presentation on effectively sharing the faith.

Two exciting city-wide opportunities are approaching. The **Rekindle the Fire Conference for Men** will take place this Saturday, February 26, from 9:00 a.m.-5:30 p.m. at the Memorial Coliseum. Register at rekindlethefire.net. On Wednesday, March 9, there will be an evening **Revive Mission** held at Bishop Dwenger High School from 6:30 p.m.-9:00 p.m. for families and people of all ages, with childcare offered. Register at Damascus.net/reviveftwayne. Both events will feature excellent speakers and should be great opportunities to lead us into a significant Lent.

Renovation Week 7. The progress continues. New windows are now installed with tinted glass, eliminating the need for the curtains. It is a nice, clean look. Along with the windows, we have had plywood installed over the top of the cornice around the church. In the years to come, this will make it much easier to climb out on the cornice and wash those windows. Workers are grinding and polishing the terrazzo floor on the north side of the church, while we still await the chemicals needed to pour the terrazzo on the south side. I include this week a photo of our altar. You will recognize the familiar marble altar top, mostly hidden under blankets for protection. When the wooden slats were removed from the altar, we found that the original 1958 legs of the altar have been enclosed with cement blocks. The cement blocks will be left in place and covered with carved marble. The marble was shipped from Italy and awaits in crates in our Gathering Space. Seven weeks down, 13 to go.
