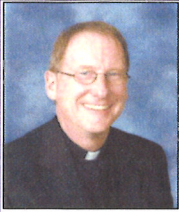

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

This weekend, we celebrate Laetare Sunday. We have a stance of joy this weekend, the half-way point of Lent. It is especially a day for joy in our parish as Kim Hoffman and Cooper Jones make a profession of faith in the Catholic Church and are Confirmed and receive their First Communion at the 9:00 a.m. Mass. We welcome them and join with them in prayer. Our parish catechumens, those who have never been baptized, have three more weeks before the solemn Easter Vigil.

While I hope and pray that we never have to face another pandemic, we are now seeing something good which came from it: We learned about livestreaming. That term wasn't even familiar to me when the pandemic began. Now we have found that there is a way to connect people to the liturgy when they aren't able to be present in the church. At this point, we have three mounted cameras in the church and a dedicated group of volunteers who are pretty proficient at offering this service. We livestream our weekly 11:00 a.m. Sunday Mass, and during Lent also our Friday evening Mass and Stations. An electronic counter shows that we are averaging around 70 people who view the Sunday Masses, and nearly that many also for our Friday Stations. For those who are able to come to Mass, the livestream does not cover a Mass obligation and it obviously doesn't allow for Holy Communion. However, for those who are homebound, and for those who are away and want to stay connected to St. Charles, the livestream is a valuable asset. It has also been a great service to connect distant family members who are unable to be here for funerals and weddings.

Each spring we cycle new members into our Parish Council. We are now recruiting people who would be willing to join us. The Parish Council meets monthly on a Wednesday evening to discuss the spiritual life, the social life, and the outreach of our parish. We have an excellent council which has provided a lot of insights and ideas and has also helped to coordinate the parish picture directory, organize ecumenical events and service opportunities. 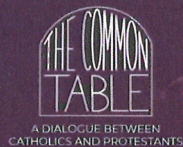
