

### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!


We welcome all of the recent good news about the waning pandemic. I'm not sure how much longer we will continue wearing masks to distribute Communion at Mass. While this practice has been dropped in most local parishes, I'm inclined to continue for the time being. I am still seeing a good number of people wearing


masks to Mass and I think that it is a very simple act of charity to follow the way of caution for those who are at-risk or have reason to worry.

The Redeemer Radio Spring Sharathon will take place this week. Our parish hour is Thursday from 1:00 p.m.-2:00 p.m. Tune in, make a pledge, and help us to support the good work being done through Catholic radio. You can also donate on the website redeemerradio.com.

We will have a discernment meeting in May to select four new members to our St. Charles Parish Council. Council members serve a three-year term with monthly meetings on Wednesday evenings. The council talks about the faith life, social life, evangelization and outreach of our parish. We will have a discernment meeting in May, praying over names and drawing them from a basket.

Renovation, Week 10. Things are moving along well, and if all continues according to schedule, we have reached the half-way point of our project. (That means also the half-way point of our gym Masses!) The good news to report this week is that we now have on hand enough of the epoxy material to finish our floor. Since the beginning of the project, that has been our biggest worry. The floor is progressing and the plumbing in the chapel has been relocated to allow for a higher ceiling. Offsite, parishioners are building a new presider's chair and working on fabricating a back door for the tabernacle. The decision has been made to install new carpet in the chapel, and to change the background color on our Stations of the Cross from blue-green to a burnt red color. Today's photo is a close-up of the face of Christ from the corpus which we had carved in Oberammergau, Germany. This carving will be mounted on an oak cross, made by parishioners from the boards of the slat wall which separated our church and our chapel. I think you will agree that this is a splendid carving.

**ABSTINENCE**—All Catholics who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.


**FASTING-**All Catholics from their 18th birthday to their 59th birthday are bound to observe the law of fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting requires limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light nourishment may be taken on two other occasions during the day. Any good reason will excuse a person from these regulations on particular occasions and for health and dietary needs. Only a contemptuous violation of all regulations would be considered seriously wrong.
