Next weekend we have a youth retreat in Huntington. Please pray for our young

people. In a culture in which less people take their faith seriously, it is a priority for our parish to encourage our youth in their faith lives. We have good things happening in our parish youth ministry.

We have another very important event taking place next weekend. At the 9:00 a.m. Mass, Jena Rejak and Brian Shuler will make a Profession of Faith in the Catholic Church. They will then receive the Sacrament of Confirmation and their First Communion. Both were baptized in Protestant churches and have been loyal participants in our RCIA this year. We are now delighted to have them join us as Catholics.

We received this week a very quick and generous gift from Pat Schubert's estate. Please remember Dave and Pat in your prayers. They were loyal members of St. Charles for many years.

Renovation Week 11. Most of the terrazzo floor is poured and the grinding and polishing continues. Workers hope this week to begin the installation of marble around the altar and on the sanctuary wall. They are awaiting a permit before they begin drywall in the chapel and high up in the cupola. Parishioners are building chairs for the presider and two concelebrating priests and we have parishioners working on the fabrication of a new tabernacle door. This gets more exciting.

### The St. Vincent DePaul Society

The St. Charles Council of St. Vincent dePaul Society will meet on Monday, March 21, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in the Hession Center, Room B. Our organization does many different corporal works of mercy, such as feeding the hungry and clothing the naked. If this is something that is important to you please plan to attend our next meeting to find out how you can lend a hand.

During the month of February we were able to help 67 individuals consisting of 41 adults and 26 children. We provided \$4,037.25 in rent and motel stays, \$535.82 in utility payments, \$45 in miscellaneous bills, \$250.00 in gas cards and \$133.00 for food which provided 700 pounds of food. In addition, we give \$200.00 monthly to St. Patrick's Parish to help an immigrant family, for a total of \$5,201.07 to help the needy. Your generous support makes this possible.

We continue to have a large number of homeless individuals coming to us for help. Many other parishes are seeing similar increases. Only through your generosity have we been able to help so many. We are very grateful for your support.




