

## A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We welcome visitors and friends who join us for our great celebration of Easter. For anyone without a stable home church, you are always welcome here. Our priests and our parish staff would be honored to meet with you, to answer your questions, to talk about your faith journey, or just to get to

know you. Casey organizes gatherings and classes for those who want to learn more. For those who are Catholic and simply haven't registered in a parish, we would be happy to have you become an official member. You can go to our parish website, stcharlesfortwayne.org and click on "I'm New" to sign up as a member.

We are very grateful for the musicians, the church decorators, the liturgy organizers, and all who have put so much work into our Holy Week liturgies. We give glory to God when we pray well. And it is a joy to celebrate these holy days in our renovated church. I think that many of us would like to forget the Holy Weeks for the past three years. Last year we were in the gym. The year before, everyone wore a mask and sanitized, with strings blocking off alternate pews, keeping us distant from one another. Most painfully, the year before was the year that our Holy Week liturgies were canceled. Parishioners could only take part in TV Masses or livestreamed Masses. We are glad to leave all of that behind us. It is a joy to be together in our beautiful church.

For those who love music, join us on Friday evening, April 14, at 7:00 p.m. for a concert with organ and piano. We are blessed with fine instruments in our parish and we will hear some concert musicians providing a wide variety of music.

We are happy to have our sound system back in good order in the church. For reasons unknown, after just nine months the microphone at the ambo malfunctioned. We used temporary microphones for several weeks while awaiting a replacement. I am told that this ambo microphone is the same model used at the altar at St. Peter's in the Vatican. I would be interested to know if Pope Francis has ever had troubles.

Next Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday, a time when we focus on the great love and mercy of our Lord. A plenary indulgence is offered to those who receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday, providing they go to confession within 20 days before or after that Sunday, and offer simple prayers for the Pope with a heart detached from sin. We will offer those prayers at each Mas next weekend. We will also welcome a visiting priest, Fr. Lee Brokaw from Peoria, at the 9:00 a.m. Mass next weekend. He is coming to St. Charles to baptize a new nephew.


