A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

We have begun Holy Week, our greatest time of prayer. Please keep the schedule of Holy Week events handy and make sure that Church is the most important part of your week. Because of the renovations, this year our great liturgies will take place in the gym. Our Holy Thursday Mass will be at 7:00

p.m.; our Good Friday service at 12:30 p.m.; the Easter Vigil at 9:00 p.m. on Saturday; and the Easter Sunday Masses at our usual times, 7:30 a.m., 9:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Other events will take place In the Church Gathering Space. We have roughly 14 hours of confessions scheduled and we will pray the Stations of the Cross on Good Friday at 3:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. in the Gathering Space. Please take part and please invite friends and relatives.

Everyone is encouraged also to find quiet prayer time during Holy Week. From Thursday evening through Saturday night, the Church Gathering Space will be open day and night for quiet prayer. Come and spend some quiet time with the Lord.

I note, too, that Divine Mercy Sunday is two weeks away, April 24. Those looking for a plenary indulgence on the Feast of Divine Mercy need to go to confession within 20 days before or after that Sunday. We are now in that time span.


We received a note of thanks from the Christ Child Society this week. We still have a few baby bottles coming in, but so far we have brought in over 180 bottles and \$ 5,500 in donations. We also received this week a note of thanks from Redeemer Radio. In the Spring Sharathon, our parish contributed \$ 13,123 to help support Catholic radio. This is one generous parish!

Renovation Week 13. Things are moving fast and the excitement mounts. Workers are attaching marble to the back wall of the sacristy, lights are being installed, and the repainted Stations are being hung. The most exciting part of our renovation is the cupola—the open space high above the altar. Light will shine down on the altar from high above and a large crucifix will be suspended, surrounded by four red candles. As I write this column, we are expecting this week an artist from St. Louis who will install paintings of sixteen angels in the cupola. In the photo you will see the eight-sided cupola and motors in the corners. These will raise and lower the candles so that they can be replaced. Our original time schedule puts us back in the church on May 20. While it is still too early to know, I'm guessing that we are on track to hit that date.


