

#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



We welcome the guests and visitors who join us this Sunday afternoon for First Holy Communion. This is a beautiful day in the lives of our children and a beautiful day in the life of the parish.

Another beautiful event takes place at St. Charles on Monday. Join us at 1:30

p.m. on May 5, for our annual May Crowning and Rosary. Our second-graders and 8<sup>th</sup> graders will lead a procession with hymns and flowers. asking for Mary's intercession during the month of May.

As we are finishing the octave of prayer following the funeral of Pope Francis, we are now ready to watch a conclave begin. For those who are reading this bulletin on Saturday, we have an exciting opportunity on Saturday evening. 




