


A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We welcome guests and family members here this weekend for First Communion. This is a wonderful day in the lives of our children and a wonderful day in the life of the parish.

We also welcome graduates from Purdue Fort Wayne, along with IVY Tech and Indiana Tech, who have been invited to the Saturday evening Mass this weekend. Fr. Koehl has been a chaplain at PFW for the Mastodon Catholic Group. The group has been very active, with weekly Masses on campus and other gatherings.

Our parish May Crowning will take place on Monday, May 8, at 1:30 p.m. We will have a procession including our second graders in their First Communion clothes, escorted by 8th graders who will help them to place flowers in vases next to the statue of Our Lady and then to crown the statue. Everyone is welcome to join us in the church Monday at 1:30 p.m. as we turn to Mary, who prays for us from heaven.

As part of our parish tithe, we provide some financial help to three Fort Wayne parishes, the tuition fund for our diocesan seminarians, and also a seminary in Uganda, East Africa. It is great fun to hear back each year from the seminary in Uganda. They send an exuberant letter of thanks with receipts, photos, and a full report of their use of our gift. 10,000 American dollars go a long way in Uganda. Their rector reports: "Most of our seminarians come from very humble and poor families, and most of the parents live below a dollar a day. You can imagine how this financial support relieved us and our parents of the financial stress we had!" Our gift this year purchased 220 textbooks, large amounts of porridge and maize flour, and we covered the construction costs of two indoor cooking stoves with cooking pans. (Seminary meals were previously cooked outdoors over an open fire.) They included pictures of their new stoves—they are made of homemade brick with a little door on the front to insert wood or charcoal for fuel.





Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As the National Eucharistic Revival reminds us, the Holy Eucharist is the sacrament of charity. Pope Benedict XVI spoke beautifully of the link between the Holy Eucharist and charity in his apostolic exhortation, *Sacramentum Caritatis:* "From the beginning, Christians were concerned to share their goods (cf. *Acts* 4:32) and to help the poor (cf. *Rom* 15:26). The alms collected in our liturgical assemblies are an eloquent reminder of this, and they are also necessary for meeting our neighbor's needs. I have been periodically offering in our bulletin brief reviews of the books I have recently read. It is so important for us to continue to read as a part of our intellectual formation, stretching and strengthening the muscles of God-given ability our to reason. Fr. Koehl

In this review: On Confidence

By: 'The School of Life' Pages: 93

Father's Rating: 6/10

On Confidence is one book of a series by an organization called 'The School of Life,' a secular initiative which is "devoted to bringing you calm, self-understanding, better relationships, deeper friendships, greater effectiveness at work and more fulfilment in your leisure time." From a first look, it seems that 'The School of Life' is a generally positive influence in an otherwise increasingly bitter and cynical culture.

On Confidence shows Confidence to be a skill which may be grown into, rather than merely a gift given only to some. Readers are assisted in thinking their way out of the usual traps which are set in one's mind which hamper healthy functioning in social scenarios. Many insights can be gained from reading On Confidence, but perhaps one of the most striking is that we are often our own worst enemies along the way toward success; that we often find ourselves feeling out of place when receiving the proper rewards of our achievements. This sort of false humility is called "Imposter Syndrome" and is covered in chapter 3 of On Confidence.

There is a necessary caveat with this book. On Confidence provides good commentary on the practical, subjective aspects of human growth in confidence, however on multiple occasions it shows that its roots are not very well formed and the underlying philosophy is problematic for a Catholic Reader. The author clearly shows a limited understanding of Christianity and Christian philosophy, wrongly associating, or at least improperly comparing, theological thought with social virtues. One paragraph in the final chapter of the book. wherein the author misunderstands the Christian definition of Meekness and makes a comparison of the Christian ideal to Marxism, directly highlights this weakness of the book. To fill in the gaps in the foundational philosophy of this book, I might encourage a reading of Saint Thomas Aguinas on the virtue of Fortitude, its parts, and the contrary vices (Summa Theologiae II-IIae, Q. 123-140).
