


A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We celebrate this weekend the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord into heaven. While it might seem a little ironic that we celebrate Jesus leaving us, we know of course that Jesus has not left us. He has returned to a place of glory in heaven while still with us here, especially in the Eucharist. He is still very much alive and present here in our world and in our lives.

We also celebrate Mother's Day this weekend. This is not a Church celebration, but a civil holiday. However, it is a holiday which we embrace. It is hard to imagine a more beautiful vocation than that of mothers. Our mothers give us life, they nourish us, they teach us, and for most of us, our mothers have had a vital role in leading us to Christ. We pray today for all of our mothers, those living and those deceased. We pray also for mothers who are struggling in their vocation and for mothers in difficult pregnancies.

Andy Barnes will be ordained a deacon next weekend in South Bend. Andy served as a seminarian in our parish in the summer of 2022, during the pandemic. While our parish activities were reduced that summer, Andy was active with our youth ministry and many other parish activities. He will also be remembered for planting the two red maple trees in front of the church. The ordination will be at 11:00 a.m. on May 18, at St. Matthew Cathedral in South Bend. We have four priests retiring in our diocese this year and one leaving to serve in Puerto Rico. We are ordaining two new priests in June and we have one returning from studies in Rome and another returning from teaching in the seminary in Maryland. As a result, there will be a lot of priests changing assignments this summer. Those new assignments are being announced in parishes this weekend. As I write this column, I believe that the three priests at St. Charles are all safe. Fr. James, Fr. Bobby and I are blessed to remain at St. Charles.






