

#### **MOTHER'S DAY PRAYER**

Loving God, as a mother gives life and nourishment to her children, so you watch over your Church. Bless these women, that they may be strengthened as Christian mothers. Let the example of their faith and love shine forth. Grant that we, their sons and daughters, may honor them always with a spirit of profound respect. Grant this through Christ our Lord.



#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

This weekend, we celebrate Mother's Day. This is not an event on the Church calendar, but a civic event. And yet, it is a beautiful time to remember a beautiful vocation. We pray for the women who gave us birth, the women who raised us, and the women who have been our spiritual guides in life.

A reminder of some calendar confusion: In the U.S., the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord is a Holy Day of Obligation. The confusion comes because we used to celebrate this feast on a Thursday, and a few dioceses in our country still do celebrate the feast this Thursday. However, most of the country, including our diocese, celebrates the Ascension next Sunday. We have no extra day of obligation this week.

I was up very early last weekend to watch the coronation ceremony from London. I am fascinated by the pomp, the pageantry, and the history of the event. I am left very uncomfortable, though, seeing the mix of Church and State. It seems to me that it took 20 centuries for the Catholic Church to learn the lesson that it is not a good idea for the Church to endorse political leaders or governments. And for a monarch to inherit the title as head of a church regardless of their theological background, their personal morality or even their interest in the faith—that surely can't be a good idea. I like to watch the pomp, but I plan to remain American and Catholic.

Another interesting aspect of the coronation: before receiving the crown, King Charles was anointed by the Archbishop of Canterbury. The commentator said that he would be anointed on the head, the hands, and on the breast. The king was taken behind a screen for the anointing, I presume to open his shirt. I was especially interested in this because of our Rite of Baptism. After a baby is baptized, we anoint the child with Sacred Chrism and pronounce that the child is now priest, prophet and king. A priest is one who has a responsibility to pray for others, a prophet has the responsibility to share the faith, and a king is one who has responsibility to serve others and build a world of peace and justice. The anointing at baptism has clear roots. When a priest is ordained, his hands are anointed with Sacred Chrism. We have Old Testament stories of oil poured over the head to anoint a new prophet. I was interested to learn about the anointing of a king at a coronation.

This Saturday, two young men from our diocese will be ordained deacons. The ordination will take place at 11:00 on May 20 at the Fort Wayne Cathedral. With only two being ordained, I would anticipate that there will be plenty of seating. Please pray for Oscar Duarte and Caleb Kruse, soon to be ordained deacons.

#### The St. Vincent DePaul Society

The St. Charles Council of St. Vincent dePaul Society will meet on Monday, May 15, at 7:00 p.m. in the Hession Center, Room B. Our organization does many different corporal works of mercy, such as

feeding the hungry and clothing the naked. If this is something that is important to you, please plan to attend our next meeting to find out how you can lend a hand.

During the month of April, we were able to help 143 individuals consisting of 57 adults and 86 children. We provided \$2,555.00 in rent and motel stays, \$911.10 in utility payments, \$475.00 in cards for gas and food, \$1,090.50 for furniture and household items and \$228.00 for food which provided 1200 pounds of food. In addition, we give \$200.00 monthly to St. Patrick's Parish to help an immigrant family. We spent a total of \$5,460.00 to help the needy.






