

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

Next weekend is a big weekend for the parish. Jake Schneider, a lifelong parishioner, will be ordained a deacon at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 22. The ordination will take place at the Cathedral of St. Matthew in South Bend. Everyone is very welcome to attend. During the ordination Mass, Jake will make solemn promises


of celibacy, obedience to the bishop, and dedication to a life of prayer with the Liturgy of the Hours. As a new deacon, Jake will return to St. Charles and preach his first homily at both the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses next Sunday, May 22. This is a joyful event for the parish.

Summer assignments for seminarians are pretty much finalized, and for the first time in a long while, we won't have a summer seminarian at St. Charles. Deacon Jake will be assigned to a parish which will be announced at the ordination. (This assignment is pretty much never the man's home parish.) Sam Martinez and Noah Isch, our other two diocesan seminarians from St. Charles, will spend the summer in Omaha at a priestly formation program. Most of the other seminarians from our diocese will be in South Bend for the summer, taking part in a program organized by Notre Dame to provide more exposure to ministries for the poor. We expect to be without a seminarian this summer.

We had a discernment meeting of the Parish Council this week. Four new members were discerned: Don Clemmer, Katie Eckrich, Jared Hoy, and Cathy Krouse. If you have ideas or insights you would like to share, don't hesitate to mention them to me or to any Parish Council member.

Renovation, Week 18. Things are getting more and more exciting as we are close to the finish. The bishop is coming for a Mass at 7:00 p.m. on May 31 and we are pretty optimistic that we will have our occupancy permit and be able to begin Masses once again in our own church. Last week the terrazzo treads for the sanctuary steps arrived and crews are now finishing the terrazzo flooring as well as laying carpet in the chapel, cry room and old sacristy. The crucifix is being suspended above the altar this week, and the sound system is going into place. Lighting is still the dicey issue. Since some of our light fixtures are still unavailable with supply chain problems, we are purchasing inexpensive fixtures to use temporarily, hoping to get the permit which allows us to move back into the church by May 31.

The attached photo shows some of our missing organ pipes, which have been safely stored in the rectory basement since December. We have pipes leaning in corners, protected by dish towels. Others are lying on the carpet, and some are in wooden cases. While we don't have a confirmation for dates, we think that the organ company will be able to come from Kansas and reassemble the organ after the dust has settled from grinding the floor terrazzo and before the May 31 Mass. Stay tuned.


